very well for the first outdoor meet of the season ... She took first place in the both the 400 and 200 by comfortable margins ... In the 400, Bodo crossed in a time of 59.97 to win the event by more than a second and a half ... She repeated her success in the 200, beating 18 other competitors with a time of 27.06, which was .93 faster than the second place runner ... Although she was the only Bison runner competing, she scored 20 team points to place Bethany sixth out of eight teams, ahead of Division II programs West Liberty State and Alderson-Broaddus ... Now back from spring break, the rest of the Bison track & field teams will be in action this Saturday at the Wheeling Jesuit Invitational.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes

Tiffany Bear took first place at the Geneva College Goetzis West Multi-Event ... Bear won four of the seven events in-

On the men's side, **Steve Backmon** took fifth in the triple jump with a leap of 13.04 meter.

... The Presidents were led by senior **Curt Jones**, who provisionally-qualified for the NCAA Championships during his win in the javelin ... He posted a throw of 59.93 meters (196'7") ... Junior **Bryan Considder** placed fourth in the shot put (13.63 meters, 44'8 ¾"), while classmate **Daniel Barringer** placed fifth in the shot put (47.82 meters, 156'11") ... Both W&J squads will be in action next Saturday at the Western Pennsylvania Championships hosted by California Univ. of Pa.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets opened their outdoor track and field season at the Muskingum Invita-



tional Saturday and had a productive day ... Five athletes were able to qualify for the ECAC Championships in May thanks to their performances ... On the women's side, freshman Marybeth Rocco stamped her ticket in the javelin and discus ... Sophomore Elisha Jones and senior Amanda Staudt also qualified in the javelin ... Senior distance runner Megan Grover won the 5,000-meter run by more than 11 seconds to qualify for ECAC's ... On the men's side, senior thrower Willy Herrington qualified in the discus ... Freshman Krystal Baker set a new school record in the triple jump (10.48 meters), as did senior thrower Tonya Lewis, who heaved the shot put 10.41 meters ... Rocco's throw of 35.55 meters also set a new school mark in the discus.

Westminster Titans

Westminster competed in its first two outdoor meets of the season in two meets hosted by



Coastal Carolina University, the Asics Invitational on March 14 and the Shamrock Invitational March 20-21 ... Both unscored meets featured many Division I athletes ... Sophomore thrower Jillian Babish broke the school discus record in the Asics Invitational with a 14th-place distance of 34.45 meters ... Babish also placed 14th in the discus in the Shamrock (31.98) ... Babish placed 17^{th} and 20^{th} in the shot put in the two meets ... Senior Megan Harding took 10th (12.69) in the 100 dash in the Asics and 14th in the Shamrock (12.49) ... Senior Amanda Smallhoover was the highest finisher for the Titan women in the Shamrock with an 11th place finish in the high jump (1.5), after she also took 11th in the Asics (1.45).
