Hadbavny captured the individual title in the discus (153-10), and placed third in the shot put (48-0) and fourth in the javelin (164-10 3/4) at the Clarion Early Bird Invitational this weekend. He qualified for the ECAC D-III Championships in both the discus and the shot put.

Chris Gardner and Lauren Spegal are becoming the unquestioned leaders for the Bethany track & field ... Gardner helped his men place in the top six of four different events while Spegal bested numerous Division II throwers to pace the Bison in a heavily-favored D-II meet ... Other top performances for the men include Daniel Orwa and Kenneth Hopper's finishes in the 800-meter run to earn 8th and 10th places, respectively ... Adam Llanos finished eighth in the javelin, earning his position with a toss of 142.58 feet ... Mallory Roadman provided the only other bright spot for the women's limited squad as the junior added a fifth-place finish in the 5000meter run with a time of 21:09.82.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J track and field opened at the Muskingum College Invitational Saturday ... On the women's side, freshman Kelli Gee won the triple jump (33'8") and placed second in the long jump (16'7") ... Her second-place finish in the long jump qualified her for the ECAC Division III Championships ... Freshman Elizabeth Mulholland also won the javelin event and gualified for the ECAC Championships with a long throw of 118'10" ... Freshman Lauren Weinheimer became the third President to gualify for the ECAC Championships after taking second in the 400 meters (59.25) ... Freshman Tony Lewis led the men's team with a firstplace finish in the long jump (21'9 1/2") ... Lewis qualified for the ECAC Championships with the first-place showing.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel competed at Saturday's Muskingum Invitational ... Junior Shaun Jackson, sophomore Ziague Douglas and freshman Anthony McCorvey each won individual titles, leading the men's team to a fourth-place finish ... Jackson won the 400 meter dash (49.98) ... Douglas ran first in the 100 meter dash (11.09), while McCorvey's jump of 42-11.75 in the triple jump was good for first ... The 4x100 meter relay team finished second in 43.03 ... Junior Kandiace Gibson claimed individual titles in both the 200 meter and 400 meter dashes with times of 26.30 in the 200 and 59.20 in the 400 ... Freshman Anoia Rhodes finished third in the javelin with a toss of 106-03.

Westminster Titans

Westminster opened its 2005 season at the Clarion Early Bird Invitational last weekend ... On the men's side, leading the way was junior Adam Hadbavny who captured the discus (153-10), placed third in the shot put (48-0) and fourth in the javelin (164-10 3/4), qualifying for the ECAC Championships in the first two events ... Also qualifying for ECACs was senior Phil Frye with a fourth-place finish in the shot put (45-8) ... For the Lady Titans, freshman Jessica Cooper captured the high jump with an ECAC-qualifying mark of 5-3 ... Cooper also placed fourth in both the 400 meter dash (1:06.20) and the triple jump (33-6), and seventh in the long jump (14-41/2).
