Bethany Bison

Despite cold temperatures, the Bison enjoyed a strong start to the outdoor season, with five Top 5 placements and one school record going down at the Wheeling Jesuit Invitational ... One first place was earned by freshman Gregg Williams, who



measured out at 21-9 to win the long jump by more than seven inches ... A new Bethany record was set by freshman Cory Yarrington in the 3,000 steeplechase, as his time of 10:27.84 placed him third overall and shattered the previous mark by more than 34 seconds ... Other Top 5 finishes came from freshman Ben Gregg, who was third in the javelin (159-7) and junior Seth Meyers, who tied for fifth in the shot put (41-8) ... The women's team was led by senior Desiree Finley, who raced to a fourth place finish in the 400 hurdles with a time of 1:08.61 ... The 4x100 relay team of Finley, junior Kaitlyn Black and freshmen Hayley Acree and Paige Prato placed seventh with a time of 52.86.

Grove City Wolverines

The Grove City thinclads opened the 2011 season with a pair of meets last week ... GCC hosted Westminster and Clarion Tuesday in an unscored meet Tuesday at Thorn Field ... On the women's side, Sara Fisher won the 1500 and the 5000 for the Wolverines ... Christen



Vallimont won the 400 hurdles and Shannon Bishop took the triple jump ... Arleigh McRae paced the men by winning the 800 and 1500 ... Garrett Cichowitz won the 5000 and Josiah Tobin won the steeplechase ... John Green (400 hurdles), Patrik Miller (triple jump) and Phil Venanzi (discus) also posted wins ... Saturday at Wheeling Jesuit, the men took 13th out of 23 teams and second among D-III programs ... Cichowitz won the 1500 and Tobin took second in the steeplechase ... The women finished as the top D-III squad at Wheeling Jesuit, taking eighth overall out of 23 squadrons ... Fisher won the 5000 while Hannah Tubb took third in the 800 with a school-record time of 2:19.87 ... Tubb finished as the top D-III entry in the 800.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcat men's and women's track and field squads competed at WJU's Bill Van Horne Invitational Saturday ... On the men's side, a trio of Tomcats topped the existing school mark in the 3,000meter run ... Richard Peterson finished third



(8:54.34), Regis Wagner fourth (8:57.08), and Brendan DuLaney rounded out the threesome's performance as he finished seventh with a time of 9:29.94 ... Scott Stano registered a fourth-place finish in the javelin with a throw of 157-10.5 ... On the women's side, Valerie White claimed an eighth-place finish in the 3,000-meter run, finishing with a time of 11:30.85 ... Cassidy Kravec earned a 12th-place finish in the javelin with her throw of 106-6.3.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg track & field opened the outdoor portion of its schedule at the Bill Van Horne Invitational, which was hosted by Wheeling Jesuit University ... The Yellow Jacket men were led by sophomore discus thrower Kurt Bonnet, who not



only won the event with a throw of 44.92 meters (147' 4"), but also qualified for the ECAC Championships ... Freshman Justin Angotti finished seventh in the 58-man 800-meter field (2:01.50) ... Waynesburg's 4x400 team of Casey Kaiser, Ethan Smith, Alan Jaeger and Trale Merz added a respectable 10th-place performance (3:37.23) ... The Yellow Jacket women were led by two-time All-American Elisha Jones, who won the 42-woman javelin competition with an ECAC-qualifying throw of 37.17 meters (121' 11") ... Freshman Kayla Shacklock led WU in the track events with an eighth-place performance in the 400-meter hurdles (1:11.02) ... She was followed closely by senior Mikey Macosko, who placed tenth (1:11.24).

Geneva Golden Tornadoes

Three more student-athletes qualified for the NCCAA track & field meet Saturday as the Golden Tornadoes competed at Wheeling Jesuit against mainly Division I and II athletes ... Julia Urbanski GOLDEN TORNADOES (800 & 1500 meter run) qualified in a pair of events with a pair of Top 10 finishes ... Kayla Jackson



qualified in the javelin with a throw of 29.12 meters ... On the men's side, Nick Edinger finished 10th in the 5K race with a time of 15:48.61, which was good enough to send him to his second consecutive NCCAA national meet ... Mary Keen posted Geneva's top finish of the day with a fourth place effort in the discus ... Keen finished behind three Division I athletes with a throw of 38.11 meters ... In the men's shot put, Dan Dillman was fourth with a toss of 13.04 meters ... Other top finishers on the day included Shannon Rech (seventh in the 3K), Aisha Moore (sixth in the triple jump) and Shaka Sydnor (eighth in the triple jump) ...

Saint Vincent Bearcats

Geneva's 4x100 men's relay team posted a sixth place finish.

The Bearcats opened the 2011 season with an 11th place finish, out of 23 teams, at the Wheeling Jesuit/ Van Horne Invitational ... Despite the frigid conditions, the Bearcats saw two team records shattered, while 10 runners turned in personal best times ... Cam Stumme led the charge individually, capturing first in



the 3000 steeplechase with a time of 10:00.86, a personal best and the second fastest time ever recorded in the event in program history ... Two other Bearcats established school records, including Shane Sweeney in the 400 intermediate hurdles (1:00.14), and Tyler Vivio in the 200 (23.53) ... In the 5K, SVC placed three runners in the top 10, led by fourth-place finisher Matt Hagg (15:34.93) and fifth-place finisher Ryan Barlow (15:36.87), while Kevin Wanichko took fifth in the 1500 (4:09.09) and Luke D'Amico fourth in the 800 (1:59.63).

Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J women's track & field earned three ECAC Championship qualifying times at the York Spring Opener two weeks ago ... Senior Michelle Wuenstel posted an ECAC time (58.30) in the women's 400 ... Classmate Katelynd McElhany earned an ECAC time by winning the 110-meter hurdles in 15.85 ... Wuenstel and McElhany teamed with freshmen Laura Lee and



Cheyenne Mangold posted the third ECAC qualifier on the women's 4x100 relay team (50.62) ... Junior Taylor Hockman placed first in three individual events on the men's side, including the 100-meter dash (11.60), long jump (6.47 meters) and triple jump (13.39 meters) ... Hockman, seniors Joe Combine and Sal Ruggeri and junior Greg French took first in the men's 4x100 relay (44.09) ... Hockman earned ECAC qualifying marks by winning the long jump (22'9 3/4") and placing third in the triple jump (42'9 1/2") at the Lynchburg Invitational nearly 10 days ago.

Westminster Titans

The Westminster men's and women's track and field teams competed at the Amy Adams Memorial Invitational hosted by Muskingum College on Saturday ... The Titan women placed second out of four teams and the Titan men



placed third out of four teams ... The Titan women won seven events and the Titan men captured two ... Junior Mallory Mack won three events, including the 100- (12.87) and 200-meter (27.84) dashes as well as leading off the winning 4x100 relay team (50.32) ... Freshman Kristen Basista and junior Alisha Slater also won events while also running legs of the 4x100 relay ... Basista won the 100 hurdles (16.38) and Slater captured the long jump (4.93) ... Other winners for the Titan women were junior Tyler Dever in the 800 (2:27.93), junior Emily Dolsak in the discus (38.05), and junior Bridget McCray in the javelin (35.29) ... On the men's side, sophomore Adam Carswell won the long jump (6.31) while senior Nathan Donolo won the javelin (45.46).
