Grove City College Junior - javelin Kane, Pa./Kane H.S.

Phillips captured the javelin at the Clarion Early Bird Invitational with a throw of 164-8, topping the second-place finisher by over three feet.

Thiel College Sophomore - throwing events Greenville, Pa./Reynolds H.S.

Hauser continued her field event domination at the Mary Washington Battleground Relays last weekend, winning the javelin competition for the third consecutive weekend. She won the event with a throw of 136-9, surpassing the NCAA provisional mark (126-4) for the second time this season. She also finished fourth in the hammer throw with a mark of 126-9.

Also nominated was senior **Melissa White** of Bethany, freshman **Elisa Pedersen** of Grove City, and freshman **Sonya Cole** of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

Bethany began the 2003 outdoor season by hosting the Bison Relays ... Both the men and the women's teams finished third out of four teams as West Liberty State won both ends of the meet ... Not one men's team claimed a victory, although the team of Aaron Weathers, Daniel Reinoso, Bryan Murray and Lavel Williams put up solid efforts in taking second in the 4x100 (45.28) and Sprint Medley (1:44,53) ... On the women's side, two teams recorded first places, including the team of Melissa White, Ashley Dougherty and Tara McNeish won the pole vault ... White also competed on the victorious javelin team with Maggie Kuhn and Carissa Moore.

The Washington & Jefferson men's track and field team placed fourth of four teams at the Bethany Relays on Saturday afternoon in Bethany, W.Va. ... Sophomore **Chad Edwards** won the shot put with a toss of 46-6, while junior **Dan Bryner** placed first in the high jump ... The 4X100 relay team, anchored by juniors **Jon Betz** and **Sam Young**, placed third in a time of 46.50 ... Both President squads return to action on Saturday as they travel to New Wilmington, Pa., to compete in the Westminster Titan Invitational at 9:00 am.

Grove City Wolverines

The Wolverine track and field teams began the season at the Clarion Early Bird Invitational Saturday ... On the women's side, freshman Elisa Pedersen won the 3000 steeplechase and the 5000 while junior Sally Lewis won the triple jump ... Lewis also took second in the long jump while Christine Rummel won the 100 hurdles and took second in the 400 hurdles ... Senior Jordyn Taylor earned runner-up in both the 100 hurdles and 100 dash ... For the men, senior Ryan Mitchell won the 3000 steeplechase while junior Rory Phillips took first in the javelin ... Senior Jeb Schreiber, the 2002 PAC MVP, finished second in the 400 hurdles and third in both the 110 hurdles and high jump.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel sophomore **Libby Hauser** is off to a magnificent start this season, winning her third consecutive javelin title at the Mary Washington College Battleground Relays in Fredricksburg, Va. on Friday ... Hauser won the event with a throw of 136-9, surpassing the NCAA provisional mark (126-4) for the second time this season ... She also finished fourth in the hammer throw with a mark of 126-9 ... The women's distance medley (1200, 400, 800, 1600) finished third and set a new school record with a time of 13:36.7

... The men's sprint medley relay, made up of sophomore **Josh Lyles**, senior **Kevin Wilder**, sophomore **Derek Pugh** and freshman **Shaun Jackson** finished third in a school record 3:32.0.

Westminster Titans

Westminster track opened the 2003 outdoor season Saturday at the Clarion Early Bird Invitational ... No team score was kept at the event ... Leading the WC men was freshman Adam Hadbavny, who was the lone Titan to capture an individual event when he won the shot put with a toss of 46-2 1/4 ... A pair of Titan men posted second place finishes: juniors Matt Steve in the 100 meter dash and Tim Snyder in the 3,000 meter steeplechase ... A pair of Lady Titans posted individual wins at the invitational ... Senior Katie Spehar captured the 800 meter run with a time of 2:24, while freshman Sonya Cole placed first in the shot put with a mark of 35-9 1/2 ... Junior Diana Barnes also finished second in the 200 meter dash for Westminster.
