

The Bison turned in several good efforts at their first full outdoor meet Saturday at Wheeling Jesuit, where the women



placed 7th out of 14 teams and the men were 10th out of 13 ... Freshman Connie Woods took first in the triple jump with an effort of 35-1.5, shattering the school record which has stood since 1990 by more than two feet ... She also placed fourth in the long jump and sixth in the 200 ... Junior Jodi Bodo was the top D-III runner and third overall in the 200 (27.12) and 400 ... Her time of 59.43 in the 400 bettered her ECAC-qualifying time from last week by a half-second ... Bodo also led off for the 400 relay team that placed sixth (52.43) and anchored the 1600 team which took fourth (4:19.65) ... For the men, Grant Walters placed fifth in the triple jump and eighth in the long jump ... Seth Myers took sixth in the discus.

#### Geneva Golden Tornadoes

Grove City opened the 2009 season with a pair of meets last week ... Tuesday, Grove City hosted an unscored quad meet


