Hadbavny posted two first place finishes and one second for Westminster at the Titan Invitational on Saturday. he captured both the discus (152-1) and javelin (161-1) while placing second in the shot put (44-3 1/2).

Also nominated was junior **Christine Rummel** of Grove City and sophomore **Carrie Fleckenstein** of Westminster.

### *Bethany Bison*

The Bison men and women each finished eighth at the Bill Horne Invitational Saturday at Wheeling Jesuit ... For the men, **Chris Gardner** finished fourth in the long jump (20-8), while **Aaron Weathers** finished fifth in the 400 (53.70) ... **Lavel Williams** finished ninth in the 100 (11.87) ... In the shot put, **Mark Brown** was fifth with a heave of 42-04.50 and the 4x100 meter relay team finished in fourth with a time of 44.27 ... For the women, **Carissa Moore** earned the highest finish of the day, placing second in the javelin with a throw of 103-01 ... **Brooke Polega** was sixth in the shot put (28-09.75) and seventh in the discus (92-3) ... **Mallory Roadman** placed sixth in the 5,000 meter run with a time of 20:27.31.

### *Wash. & Jeff. Presidents*

The Washington & Jefferson men's track and field team placed 14th out of 15 teams at the Western Pennsylvania Championships hosted by Carnegie Mellon on Saturday ... Junior **Chad Edwards** placed third in the shot put event with an outdoor personal-best throw of 48' 5 1/4" ... Edwards finished as the top competitor from all Division III schools competing and also qualified for the ECAC Championships ... W&J returns to Carnegie Mellon for the CMU Invitational this Saturday.

### *Grove City Wolverines*

Grove City placed 10<sup>th</sup> in both the men's and women's competition at CMU Saturday, which featured numerous Division I and II programs ... Senior **Rory Phillips** won the javelin with a throw of 195 feet while senior **Steve Brown** took third in the 10,000 ... Frosh **Sam Dippold** claimed fourth in the 400 hurdles and senior **Dan Corsi** took fifth in the discus ... Senior **Sally Lewis** helped lead the women's team by taking third in the long jump and fifth in the triple jump and was the top Division III competitor in both events ... Junior **Christine Rummel** finished fourth in both hurdle events and eighth in the triple jump ... Freshman **Cara Pierce** finished fourth in the steeplechase.

### *Thiel Tomcats*

The Thiel men's and women's track and field teams participated in the Western Pa. Championships Saturday at Carnegie Mellon ... The men's team finished tied for seventh place with 39.0 team points while the women's team finished in 12th place with 23.0 points ... Freshman **Lou Scudere** ran to a third-place finish in the 100-meter dash (11.34) and finished fifth in the 200 meters with a time of 23.17 ... Senior **Richard Purdy** placed third in the high jump (6-00) ... Sophomore **Kandiace Gibson** paced the women's squad Saturday, finishing third in both the 100 meters (13.18) and the 200 meters (26.37) ... Junior **Libby Hauser** placed eighth in both the javelin (124-8) and the shot put (36-1).
