#### **Bethany Bison**

The Bison battled through harsh elements at Saturday's W&J Invitational to post several strong performances ... The top effort came from freshman Arkangelo James in the 800, where he placed second with a time of 1:57.51, just over a second



away from the school record ... Also posting Top 5 finishes on the men's side was freshman Ben Gregg, who was 3rd in the javelin (159-0), and freshman Gregg Williams, who took 4th in the long jump (21-2.75) ... Both the 4x100 (44.56) and 4x400 (3:33.99) relays earned 6th place showings as well ... The women's team was led by senior Desiree Finley, who had a hand in all of the team's points ... She raced to a 3rd place finish in the 400 hurdles (1:09.59), claimed 6th place overall in the 100 hurdles (16.41) and teamed with Hayley Acree, Kaitlyn Black and Paige Prato to take fifth place in the 4x100 relay (52.51).

#### **Grove City Wolverines**

The Grove City College track and field teams competed in the W&J Invitational Saturday at Cameron Stadium ... The women took eighth in the team standings and the men captured 13th ... On the women's side, sophomores Sara Fisher and Ella Smith finished 1-2 in the 10,000-



meter run ... Hannah Tubb took second in the 800 while Brigitte Fryan (5,000) and Emily Pierce (1,500) both recorded fourth-place finishes ... Tubb, Cayla Clawson, Grace Postma and Austin Powell finished fourth in the 1,600 relay ... John Green, Patrik Miller, Nick Philpot and Lester Bragg comprised the fourth-place 1,600 relay on the men's side ... Green also took fifth in the 400 hurdles ... Garrett Cichowitz took fifth in the 5,000 and Francis Ridge took fifth in the 10,000 ... The Wolverines will compete in the Slippery Rock University Invitational Saturday.

#### Thiel Tomcats

Thiel competed in a tri-meet at Slippery Rock University against a pair of Division II teams in Slippery Rock and California (Pa.) ... Ethan Rowe was the lone winner for the Tomcats, taking first in the 400meter dash with a time of 51.30 ... Posting runner-



up performances for Thiel were Richard Peterson (1,500), Regis Wagner (3,000-meter steeplechase), Cassidy Kravec (javelin) and Emily Petrak (800) ... The Tomcats also had three athletes take third, including Moriah Monroe (200), Cyrill Parham (shot put) and Justin Starks (100).

#### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Despite battling a large, talented field and cold, rainy conditions, Waynesburg had a successful Saturday at the W&J Invitational ... The Yellow Jacket men placed eighth in the 19-team field and were led for a second-straight week by sopho-



more thrower Kurt Bonnet, who placed second in the 42-man field in the discus ... Bonnet's top throw measured 44.46 meters (145' 10") and placed him first amongst all D-III competitors ... Freshman Justin Angotti added a sixth-place effort in the 800-meter run with a time of 1:59.96 ... The Waynesburg women were paced by senior standout Elisha Jones, who won the javelin for the second time in as many weeks ... Her top throw sailed 36.76 meters (120' 7") and bested the second-place finisher by more than 1.5 meters ... Junior Krystal Baker and freshman Bre Paul placed third and fourth, respectively, in the pole vault with jumps of 2.8 meters (9' 2.25") ... Baker also placed sixth in the high jump after clearing 1.46 meters (4' 9.5").

#### Geneva Golden Tornadoes

Geneva joined several PAC schools at the Washington & Jefferson Invitational Saturday ... Geneva's women finished 13th and the men came in 14th, but the individual performances stole the show ... In GOLDEN TORNADOES women's action, Sarah Davis joined the ever-growing number of NCCAA national qualifiers with a fifth



place performance in the 10K race ... Other Top 10 women's performances included Mary Keen (2nd - Discus), Kayla Jackson (8th -Shot put), Julia Urbanski (2nd - 1500 meter; 7th - 800 meter) and Alayna Merkle (8th - 5K) ... Geneva's men were equally impressive In the throwing and distance competitions with five Top 10 finishes ... Nate Mansor trimmed 24 seconds off his personal best time while finishing 8th in the steeplechase ... Chuck Walters came in 6th in the 10K event ... Dan Dillman turned in a pair of top tens in the discus and shot put while Nick Edinger again made a major splash by winning the 10K race and setting a new meet record with a time of 33:10.08.

#### Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Bearcats took ninth out of 19 teams at the frigid Washington & Jefferson Invitational ... Fifteen different runners tallied personal-best times for the Bearcats, while Tyler Vivio and Shane Sweeney each set new school marks, with the former posting a time of 23.26 seconds in the 200, and the latter 58.42 seconds in the



400Intermediate Hurdles ... Kevin Wanichko had a big day, winning the 1500 with a time of 3:58.29, the fastest time recorded this spring by a PAC runner ... Wanichko also teamed up with Sweeney, Chansler Poole, and John Joseph to take third in the 4x400 relay, with a time of 3:29.96 ... Cam Stumme set a personal best in the 3000 Steeplechase, taking fourth with a time of 9:56.07, while Poole took fifth in the 1500 (4:03.87), and Lucas Briola ninth in the 10,000 (35:12.45).

#### Washington & Jefferson Presidents

The W&J track & field teams both placed sixth at the Sixth Annual W&J Invitational Saturday at Cameron Stadium ... The women scored 54.5 points, while the men accumulated 66.5 ... Junior Taylor Hockman paced the men by winning the long jump (23'1 1/4") ... The junior also took second in the triple jump (43'11 1/ 4"), fifth in the 100 meters (11.44) and helped the 4x100



relay team take third (43.39) ... Senior Katelynd McElhany was second in the 100 (15.05) and 400 (1:08.71) hurdles ... She was also the lead on the 4x400 (4:16.79, 3rd place) and 4x100 (50.84, 4th place) relays ... Freshman Cheyenne Mangold ran a leg on both relays and also placed fifth in the 800 (2:22.39) ... Freshman Lindsey Coffey was fourth in the high jump (4'11 1/2") ... Junior C.J. Corcoran took fifth in the high jump (4'9 1/2") and sixth in the javelin (106'5") ... Sophomore Scott Ryan placed fourth in the 800 (1:59.30) and 1,500 meter (4:02.48) events.

#### Westminster Titans

The Westminster men won the Wooster Invitational Friday at the College of Wooster ... The Titan women placed third at the meet ... The Titan men won a meet for the first time since they won the 1995 KECC Championships ...



Six men's and women's teams competed in the event ... Westminster captured a combined nine events (eight field events) ... The Titans won both the men's and women's pole vault at events as sophomore Mark Saylor and junior Merrissa Malcolm each prevailed with vaults of 4.57 and 3.2 meters, respectively ... WC also swept the men's and women's discus and javelin ... Junior Emily Dolsak won the women's discus at 35.67 and sophomore Chris Weeda took the men's at 34.29 ... Junior Bridget McCray won the women's javelin at 35.84 and junior Ryan Bell captured the men's at 56.29 ... Sophomore John Proano took the triple jump (11.79) and freshman Anthony Thomas won the long jump (6.61) ... Junior Mallory Mack won the 100 dash (12.91).
