Bethany Bison

The Bison enjoyed a banner day at the W&J Invitational Saturday with three individuals and one relay winning events and one school record going down ... Senior Taylor McNeil had the biggest day for

the Bethany men, winning the 200 (22.35) and anchoring the 4x100 relay of Daniel Farray, Marcus Johnson and Ed Holmes to a first place finish with a time of 43.64 ... McNeil also placed fourth in the 100 (11.05) and ran the third leg on the 4x400 relay that took 3^{rd} (3:32.32) ... For the women, Erin Reske won the 10,000 (42:48.64) and Desiree Finley took first in the pole vault (10-2) ... The broken school record came in the 200, where Jodi Bodo took second with a time of 25.89 to re-set her own mark ... Bodo also placed second in the 400 (58.52) and anchored the 4x400 relay of Finley, Kaitlyn Black and Emily Andrews to a second place showing (4:12.41) ... Other top placements came from Maggie McCort in the 5,000 (fourth), Finley in the 100 hurdles (fourth) and Cassie Allen in the high jump (fourth).

Grove City Wolverines

A handful of Grove City athletes competed in the Washington & Jefferson Invitational Saturday at Cameron Stadium ... On the men's side, senior Matt Six won the discus with a toss of 146-9 He also placed fourth in

the shot put with a mark of 45-61/2 ... Paige Polesnak paced the women by clearing 4-7 in the high jump, good for seventh in the field ... Grove City will compete in the Slippery Rock University Invitational Saturday at the Bill Lennox Track inside N. Kerr Thompson Stadium.

Thiel Tomcats

The Thiel track & field teams earned nine top-three finishes at the Jack Hazen Open Saturday ... Senior Latoya Locke led the way for the women, fin-

ishing first in the 100-meter hurdles in15.72, while also placing second in the 200-meter dash ... Freshman phenom Brittany Brown finished second to Locke in the hurdles with a time of 15.75, while placing third in the high jump with a leap of 1.62-meters ... First-year thrower Cassidy Kravec rounded out the women's top performers with a second place heave of 35.54-meters in the javelin... Perennial All-America senior Alex Eaton earned the men's only first place finish of the day, with a time of 50.48 in the 400-meter dash, while Ethan Rowe placed second in the event in 50.73 ... Rowe also earned third place in the 200-meter dash with a time of 23.08, while Scott

Stano rounded out the men's top finishers, placing second in the

javelin with a throw of 48.52 ... The Thiel track & field teams will com-

pete again at the Mount Union Open, this Saturday, April 10.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

It was a good Saturday for the Waynesburg track & field program as both the men and women enjoyed fruitful days at Washington & Jefferson ... The Yellow Jacket women tied for the team championship with Allegheny after putting up 112 team



points ... Middle distance runner Maria Shepas and sprinter Rhea Huwe earned individual titles in the 1,500-meter run and the 100-meter dash, respectively ... Krystal Baker, the team's jumping specialist, enjoyed another tremendous all-around performance in the field events ... She placed second in the high jump (1.5 meters, 4-11), second in the pole vault (3.1 meters, 10-2) and third in the triple jump (10.77 meters, 33-6) ... On the men's side, hurdler Trale Merz and thrower Doogie Sanner each picked up wins in their individual specialties ... Merz won the 400-meter hurdles, while Sanner earned his first collegiate win in the javelin ... The Jacket men placed sixth as a squad.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes

First-year coach Brian Yowler continues to preach constant improvement to his young team ... Saturday, the maturation process continued with some very impressive individual performances at W&J GOLDEN TORNADOES ... In women's action, Aisha Moore turned in three



Top 10 finishes while teammate Liz Michalak had a pair of Top 10 efforts and three season-best performances along the way ... Geneva's top female finisher was Shannon Rech with a second place overall effort in the 5K race despite unseasonably warm temperatures ... The men's team had an equally exciting day with two more student-athletes qualifying for the NCCAA national meet ... Monas Cunningham finished third and fourth, respectively, in the 110 and 400 meter hurdles ... He gualified for nationals in both events ... Teammate Corey Fraction put his name on the national qualifying list with his 11.36 effort in the 100 meter dash ... The Golden Tornadoes will dip into the Division I pool at the end of the week when they visit Robert Morris.

Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Bearcats took part in the Washington & Jefferson Invitational over the weekend, and took ninth out of 14 teams, despite competing in only six of 20 events. In the deep field, a number of SVC runners placed strong finishes ... Jared Ryan took fourth in the 800, with a career-best time of 2:00.35, while Jeff Hite finished



fourth (16:16) and Ryan Barlow eighth (16:45) in the 5K ... Cam Stumme ran a career-best 10:35.26 in the 3K steeplechase, a career best, while Kevin Wanichko ran a season-best 4:12.11 in the 1500, good for ninth place ... In relay action, the foursome of Sweeney, Stumme, Wanichko, and Ryan finished fourth in the 4x400, timed in 3:33.67.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents

The Washington & Jefferson College men's track & field team racked up 115 points to earn a secondplace finish Saturday at the 2010 W&J Invitational, while the women's team finished seventh with 54 points ... Junior Michelle Wuenstel highlighted the day for the Presidents as she set two meet records in the 200-



meter dash (25.79) and the 400-meter dash (57.60) ... Sophomore Greg French also had a big day on the men's side as he posted a firstplace finish in the 110-meter hurdles (15.58), a second-place finish in the triple jump (12.86 meters) and a third-place finish in the 400-meter hurdles (56.57) ... He also ran the final leg for W&J's 4x100-meter relay team, which finished second in the event with a time of 43.99 ... Both the men's and women's teams will return to action on Saturday morning, traveling to Pittsburgh for the 2010 Carnegie Mellon Invitational.
