Bethany Bison

One school record fell Saturday and several others were nearly toppled when Bethany ran at the W&J Invitational ... Sophomore **Desiree Finley** broke the pole vault record and took fourth place by clearing 10-0 ... Among the

other records that were nearly rewritten included the women's 4x100, as the team of **Jodi Bodi**, **Emily Bota**, **Jessica Sarro** and **Rachael Katsur** took seventh in 51.66, just .03 away from breaking the school mark ... **Maggie McCort**, who finished third in the 1,500 in 5:07.77, three and a half seconds off the previous record ... **Chantal Stettinius** had the highest finish among BC runners by taking second in the 3,000 steeplechase (12:26.14) ... For the men, **Matt Cruse** took second in the 400 hurdles with an ECAC Qualifying time of 55.86.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City competed in Malone College's Jack Hazen Open Saturday in North Canton, Ohio ... On the women's side, freshman **Emily Pierce** took fourth in the 1000-meter run while senior **Mary Majchrowicz** placed fifth in the

400 ... Junior **Sara Wagoner** took fifth in the 400 hurdles ... In men's action, sophomore **Sean Domer** picked up his second straight title in the javelin with a toss of 190-11 ... **Matt Kulinski** cleared 14-4 in the pole vault to take second while **Dan Spaulding** placed second in the 5K ... GCC also earned runner-up in the 4x800 meter relay as **Jonathan Coopersmith**, **Dustin Heath**, **Darin Miller** and **Derek Kruse** posted a time of 8:04.88 ... Grove City will host a quadrangular meet at Thorn Field Wednesday at 5 p.m.



Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats competed at the Marv Frye Invitational, hosted by Ohio Wesleyan Saturday ... The men finished second (86), while the women placed seventh (51) ... Sophomore **Alex Eaton** posted wins in the 200 (22.22) and 400 meter dashes (49.44) and ran anchor on the

winning 1,600-meter relay squad (3:19.85) ... Other members of the winning 4x400 relay were juniors **Dorran Coley**, **Deighton Williams** and senior **Will Mills** ... Coley registered a winning time of 14.62 in the 110-meter high hurdles and provisionally qualified for the 2008 NCAA Championships ... Coley also finished fifth in the 200 (22.90) ... On the women's side, sophomore **LaToya Locke** was the Tomcats' lone winner on Saturday, finishing with a jump of 35-10.5 in the triple jump.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg set five school records Saturday at the Washington & Jefferson College Invitational ... Sophomore **April Loving** set school records in both the 100 and 200-meter dashes and qualified for the ECAC

Championships in the 100 meters ... Junior **Ashley Dodd** and freshman **Elisha Jones** each captured individual titles in the pole vault and javelin, respectively, for the second-straight week ... Junior **Becca Geisel** set the school record in the triple jump, while freshman **Michaeline Macosko** broke her own school record in the 400-meter hurdles ... On the men's side, freshman **Adam Swingle** set the school-best mark in the 1500-meter run.



Geneva Golden Tornadoes

For the second consecutive week, Geneva's men's track team was held off the scoreboard ... **Dan Dillman** did pick up a pair of top 20 performances in the shot put and discus ... The women's team for the Golden Tornadoes stole the spotlight with

first place finishes from Rebecca VanRegenmorter (5,000 meters) and Susan Fletcher (3,000 meter steeplechase) ... Kelsey Anderson picked up three top 10 finishes, including fourth place in the 400 meter hurdles ... Geneva's 1,500 meter team placed three of the top seven finishers, led by Laura Seyler's fourth place overall finish ... Geneva will open its home schedule Wednesday, welcoming three PAC opponents to the Merriman Athletic Complex.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

Saint Vincent participated at the W&J Invitational, finishing sixth out of 14 teams ... Adam Smith took first in the 5K, besting his own school record and qualifying for the 2008 ECAC Championships with a time of 15:13.11 ... Scott Steel set a pair of school marks, finishing first overall

in the 110 high hurdles (15.49) and taking 10th in the 400 IM hurdles (1:00.21) ... **Craig Anderton's** time of 1:55.66 in the 800m set a school record and was good for second place overall, while **Wayne Hooper** entered the SVC record books and qualified for the ECAC's with a time of 4:02.67 in the 1500m run, good for third place ... The Bearcat 4x400 relay squad took fifth place and set a school record with a time of 3:29.14.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J hosted an invitational at Cameron Stadium Saturday .. The women's squad placed third, while the men grabbed fifth ... Senior **Kelli Gee** won the triple jump (10.9m) and helped the 4x100 relay to a win (49.37) ... She also claimed second place in the long jump (5.3m) and sixth in the 100 meters (13.41) ... Freshman **Michelle**

Wuenstel topped the field in the 400 meters (58.86) and placed second in the 200 meters (27.02) ... Junior **Brittany Anderton** placed third in the long jump (5.02m) and 400 meter hurdles (1:10.70) ... The men were led by junior **Curt Jones**, who won the javelin (54.34 meters) ... Junior **Jeff Smith** earned a fourth-place showing in the 400-meter hurdles (57.21), while senior **Doug Melton** claimed fifth in the discus (40.96 m).



Westminster Titans

Westminster competed in the unscored Jack Hazen Open hosted by Malone College Saturday ... Four new school records were set by three Titan women ... WC women held

23 top-eight place-winners in 14 events, while the Titan men got five place-winners in three events ... Junior sprinter **Megan Harding** broke her own school record time of 12.56 in the 100 by running a second-place time of 12.45 Saturday ... Harding also cut her school-record time of 25.58 in the 200 down to 25.55 for second place at the meet ... Junior **Rebecca Shiner** broke a five-year-old school record in the 800 meters with a third-place time of 2:21.13, beating the old mark of 2:24.9 held by **Katie Spehar** in 2003 ... Senior **Jess Cooper** won the high jump by breaking her own school record with a season-high distance of 1.67 meters ... Junior **Katelyn Kushner** won the 400 hurdles at 1:06.11.
