#### Bethany Bison

Bethany's women broke two school records and equaled another in a strong performance at W&J Saturday ... Jodi



Bodo had a hand in both records on the track, as she reset her own mark in the 200 by taking 1st place with a time of 26.56, clipping .24 off the standard she set last year ... Bodo also teamed with freshman Kaitlyn Black and sophomores Kelly and Stacy Goode to win the 4x400 relay in 4:07.25, which shattered the BC record by more than 4 seconds and also qualified the relay for ECAC Championships ... Bodo's day included finishing second in the 400 (59.49) and taking fifth in the 4x100 relay along with Black, Emily Bota and Rachael Katsur ... Connie Woods matched her own record from the previous week in the triple jump with an effort of 35-1.75, tying her for third place.

#### Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Bearcats turned in a solid showing at the W&J

Invitational Saturday, taking

sixth place with a team score of 53 points ... The SVC 4x400 relay squad of Craig Anderton, Shane Sweeney, Kevin Wanichko, and Shane Anderton turned in the Bearcats' top performance of the day, taking first place out of 13 teams with a time of 3:26.25, to win by nearly three seconds ... In the 5K, four Bearcats finished in the top 12, paced by Adam Smith's second-place time of 15:48.32 ... Ryan Barlow finished third, Mike Hannon ninth, and Josh Hooke 12<sup>th</sup> ... In the 800, the Bearcats had three runners place in the top 10, led by Shane Anderton's second place time of 1:56.52 ... Craig Anderton followed closely behind, taking third in 1:56.93, while Adam Tucek took seventh with a time of 2:02.17 ... Kevin Wanichko's personal-best time of 4:04.84 in the 1500 meter was good for second.

#### Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J placed third and sixth, respectively, Saturday at the fourth annual W&J Track & Field Invitational at Cameron Stadium ... Senior thrower

Curt Jones paced the men as he won the javelin with a new meet record of 55.46 meters, while freshman Bryant Wang brought home first in the 110-meter hurdles (15.46) ... The President women also had two student-athletes earn titles ... Sophomore Katelynd McElhany won two events, while senior Summer Baumgard placed first in the high jump (1.57 meters) ... McElhanv crossed the finish line first in the 100-meter hurdles (15.65) and also won the long jump (5.42 meters) ... Sophomore Michelle Wuenstel won the 400-meter dash in 58.89 and just missed breaking her meet record from a year ago ... Both the W&J men and women travel to Bucknell Friday, before competing at Robert Morris Saturday.

Tim Su clamied third in the 5000, while Frankie Hourigan took third in the steeplechase ... Two women's runners won titles Saturday ... Freshman Morgan Osterhouse won the steeplechase in a school-record time of 11:58.80 ... Senior Kristen Carter won the 5000 in 18:11.99 ... Freshman Emily Pietrucha took second in the 1500 and third in the 800 ... Grove City will compete in the Slippery Rock Open this Saturday.

#### Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcat men's and women's track and field teams put on an impressive showing at the Marv Frye



Invitational Saturday ... Thiel placed first in four events, and finished in the top three in eight .... Dorran Coley took first place in the 110-meter high hurdles with a provisional qualifying time of 14.81 ... He also was a member of the 4x400relay team that placed first in 3:18.72 ... Cara Riffe finished second (59.35) in the 400-meter dash ... Riffe would also take third place in the 200 (26.37) and fourth in the 100 (12.87) ... Riffe and the rest of the women's 4x100 relay team placed second with a time of 49.82 ... Kim Stitt led all Tomcat field athletes with a third place finish in the triple jump and a fifth place finish in the shot put ... Thiel returns to action on Saturday when they visit Robert Morris University.



#### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg split up and went to two different events Saturday ... The Yellow Jackets were rep-



resented at both the W&J Invitational and the Don Frail Invitational at Marietta College ... The group at Marietta was led by All-Americans Ashley Dodd and Elisha Jones ... Dodd set a new meet record in the pole vault when she cleared the bar set at 3.41 meters (11-2 1/4) ... Jones was victorious in the javelin after a toss of 39.21 meters (128-8) ... The Jacket women also enjoyed a good day at W&J as senior Megan Grover and freshman Krystal Baker both qualified for the ECAC Championships ... Grover gualified in the 10,000-meter run after shattering the school record with a time of 37:56.70 ... Baker won the triple jump with a school record 11.09 meters (36-4 3/4) ... For the men, sophomore Trale Merz set new school records in both the 110 and 400-meter hurdles.

#### Westminster Titans

The Westminster men's and women's track and field teams each placed sixth at the



Jack Hazen Open, hosted by Malone University Saturday ... The Titan men placed sixth out of 12 teams with 51 points, while the Titan women placed sixth out of 11 teams with 66.5 points ... For the men, freshman Morgan Hanes captured second in the 3,000 steeplechase (10:49.84), while junior Jonathan Morrow took second in the javelin (49.36).
