McLaughlin and Wilson earned co-PAC Athlete of the Week laurels after each won their event at the Westminster Titan Invitational. McLaughlin captured the javelin with a toss of 180-10, while Wilson won the 110 meter high hurdles with a time of :15.00.

PAC WOMEN'S TRACK & FIELD ATHLETE OF THE WEEK

LIBBY HAUSER

Thiel College Freshman - javelin/discus Greenville, Pa./Reynolds H.S.

Hauser earned PAC Women's Track Athlete of the Week honors for the third time this year after capturing her third straight javelin title at the Case Western Reserve Invitational. Her toss of 135-7 topped the NCAA Division III automatic qualifying mark of 134-6, qualifying her for the national championships in St. Paul, Minn., on May 23-25. She also placed fifth in the hammer throw (112-1).

Also nominated was sophomore **Maggie Kuhn** of Bethany, sophomore **Sally Lewis** of Grove City and sophomore **Courtney Posey** of Washington & Jefferson.

Bethany Bison

The Bison had several good performances at the Westminster meet ... Senior **Zach Cavalier** placed third in the javelin with a throw of 169-3, while sophomore **Adam Llanos** finished seventh with a heave of 145-1 ... In the shot put, senior **Dwayne Wright** placed ninth with his best effort of 42-5 ... The top women's finishers were freshman **Ashley Dougherty** in the pole vault (seventh at 7-0) and sophomore **Maggie Kuhn** in the javelin (sixth at 92-0).

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Washington & Jefferson men's and women's track and field finally got in their first event of the outdoor season on Saturday at Westminster ... Freshman Shawn Wilson picked up the Presidents' lone first-place finish of the day by claiming the 110 meter high hurdle title in 15.00 ... Junior Roger Snyder also placed third in the 100 meters (11.30) and sixth in the long jump (19-6) ... Sophomore Scott Chodor also finished fourth in the discus event with a toss of 126-0 ... On the women's side, the Presidents were led by sophomore Courtney Posey, who finished 10th in the 3000 meters (12:24.58).

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City opened its 2002 season Saturday at the Westminster Invitational ... Junior Sloan McLaughlin and sophomore Rory Phillips posted a 1-2 finish in the javelin with McLaughlin throwing 180-10 and Phillips recording a 174-10 ... Senior Scott Sukits placed first in the men's high jump with a leap of 6-2 ... Sophomore Sally Lewis was a doublewinner, claiming victory in both the long jump (16-9) and triple jump (34-8), while junior Jessica Cooper won the pole vault (10-0).

Thiel Tomcats

Freshman Libby Hauser was crowned champion in the javelin with a throw of 135-7, surpassing the NCAA automatic qualifying mark of 134-6 ... She will now compete at the NCAA Division III Track and Field National Championships at Macalester College (St. Paul, Minn.) on May 23-25 ... She also finished fifth in the hammer throw (112-01) ... Freshman Kristen Benjamin earned three top-five finishes on the afternoon: a third place finish in the shot put with a toss of 36-11 1/2, a fourth place finish in the hammer with a throw of 113-2, and another fourth place in the discus (113-2) ... Benjamin's performance in the shot put qualified her for the ECAC Outdoor Track and Field Championships in May.

Westminster Titans

Westminster hosted its first on-campus track & field events in over 20 years last week, with a quad meet on Wednesday and a nine-team invitational on Saturday ... Senior Jacob Gleason led the men by capturing the 5,000 meter run on Wednesday and the 3,000 steeplechase on Saturday ... Senior Ashley Pyle led the Lady Titans, winning the 100 on Wednesday and sweeping the 100 & 200 on Saturday ... Lady Titan junior Briana Palko won the high jump at both meets ... Other WC winners on Wednesday included senior Ron Brown (long jump), junior Andy Pazul (high jump) and freshman Derek Myers (javelin) ... Saturday winners included sophomore Matt Steve in the 200 and junior Dan Beckwith in the 400.
