Sophomore - sprints/pole vault Derby, N.Y./Lakeshore Central H.S.

Weinheimer posted three wins while adding a second and a fourth for the Presidents at the W&J Invitational Saturday. She won both the 200 (26.69) and 400 (1:00.34) while leading the winning 4x400 relay team (4:13.12). Her 4x200 relay team placed second (ECAC-qualifying 51.42) while adding a fourth in the pole vault (9-5 1/4).

Also nominated was sophomore **Nicole Jones** of Bethany, freshman **Kristen Carter** of Grove City, senior **Kandiace Gibson** of Thiel, freshman **Megan Grover** of Waynesburg, and sophomore **Jessica Cooper** of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

Two first place finishes highlighted Bethany's solid day at the W&J Invitational Saturday ... Sophomore **Marcus Adams** finished first in the high jump, clearing 5-10 3/4 ... He also took third in the 100 (11.66) ... The other first place

was earned by sophomore **Nicole Jones**, who won the javelin with a throw of 109 feet ... Junior **Herman Nuckols** posted a second-place finish in the long jump (20-8) and third place in the 200 (22.88) while sophomore **Lauren Spegal** finished third in the shot put (34-8.25) and discus (100-7) ... Freshman **Jennifer Smith** placed second in the high jump (5-1), while senior **Mallory Roadman** crossed third in the 5K (19:36) and freshman **Mandi Swiger** was fourth in the 400 (1:05.26).



Grove City Wolverines

Both Grove City teams placed second in Geneva College's 6-team Merriman/Butler Invitational Friday in Beaver Falls ... The men's team of Sam Dippold, Yu Kuwabara, Mark Murchie and Chris Allebach closed the meet

by winning the 4x400 relay (3:29.25) ... Chris Andrew won the steeplechase in 10:11 to secure Grove City's lone individual win ... Dippold also took second in the 400 hurdles (59.12) while sophomore Bob Rummel took second in the high hurdles ... Freshman Kristen Carter led the women's effort by winning the 5K (18:50.04) ... Carter, Brittany Croft, Kate Bender and Amanda Hewitt combined to win the 3200-meter relay while Bender, Brittany Moore, Mary Majchrowicz and Samantha Gathers won the 1600 relay.



Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats competed at the Marv Frye Invitational, hosted by Ohio Wesleyan University, on Friday ... Freshman **Dorran Coley** won both the 110-meter hurdles (14.75) and 400-meter hurdles (56.01) to lead the Tomcat men to a fourth-place finish ... Coley teamed with sopho-

more Will Mills and freshmen Steve Witherspoon and Elliot Wreh-Wilson to win the 4x100 relay (school record 42.27) ... Sophomore Anthony McCorvey won the men's triple jump (43-0) ... Senior Kandiace Gibson recorded a pair of victories in the 100 (12.74) and 200 meter (25.12) dashes to help the Thiel women to a fifth-place finish ... She provisionally qualified for the NCAA Champion-ships in the 200 ... Senior Libby Purdy won the javelin throw (127-6), just one inch off of provisionally qualifying for nationals.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J hosted its 2nd annual invitational at Cameron Stadium Saturday ... The President women finished second in the invitational and were led by sophomore **Lauren Weinheimer**, who grabbed two individual wins and led the 4x400 relay squad to a victory (4:13.12) ... Weinheimer placed first in the 200 (26.69) and 400 (1:00.34)

... Her 400 time qualifies her for the ECAC Championships ... Weinheimer also helped the 4x200 relay team to a second-place showing with an ECAC-qualifying time of 51.42 and also placed fourth in the pole vault (9'5 1/4") ... Sophomore **Kelli Gee** was a member of both relays and also earned three top five finishes ... Sophomore **Brian Skokowski** was the only W&J male to win an event as he took the shot put with an ECAC-qualifying mark of 47'6 1/2".

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Waynesburg men finished fourth in a tenteam field Saturday at the W&J Invitational Waynesburg's women placed seventh in a nine-team field ... Senior Ivan Hawkins headlined the meet by claiming two individual titles and anchoring the 4 x 100-meter relay ... For the second straight week, Hawkins won both

the 100 and 200-meter dashes and has qualified for the ECAC Championships in both events ... Senior **Jerry Powell** took second in the discus (41.03 meters), while sophomore **Troy Beattie** registered a third-place finish in the javelin (159-10) ... Leading the women was freshman **Megan Grover**, who took a pair of top-five finishes ... In the 1500 meters, the freshman placed fifth with a time of 5:11.37, then she added a second-place in the 5000 meters (19:01.64), qualifying her for the ECAC Championships.



Westminster Titans

Westminster posted three new school records and six first place finishes Saturday at the unscored Mount Union Invitational ... Senior **Adam Hadbavny** captured the discus with a mark of 168-3 1/2, breaking his own school record by nearly 10 feet ... The Lady Titans were paced by sophomore **Jessica Cooper**, who posted three first place finishes: the high jump (5-2), triple jump (school-record 35-11 1/2) and as a member of the 4x100 relay team (52.01) ... Other Lady Titan winners included senior **Sonva Cole** in the shot put (11.64)

meters) and freshman **Kristen VanSickel** in the 400 meter dash (1:00.91) ... In addition, freshman **Veronica Geretz** set a new school record with her fourth-place finish in the 400 meter hurdles (1:07.85). Joining Cooper on the 4x100 relay win were VanSickel, senior **Reese Robinson** and sophomore **Seun Olarewaju**.
