PAC MEN'S TRACK & FIELD ATHLETE OF THE WEEK

LOU SCUDERE

Thiel College

Freshman - Sprints Brookfield, Ohio/BrookfieldH.S.

Scudere claimed individual titles in both the 100 (11.02) and 200 (22.30) while leading Thiel's winning 4x400 relay team (3:24.10) at the Marv Frye Invitational at Ohio Wesleyan University in Delaware, Ohio. He also was a member of the 4x100 team which placed fourth in 43.80.

Also nominated was freshman **Chris Gardner** of Bethany, junior **Chad Edwards** of Washington & Jefferson, and sophomore **Adam Hadbavny** of Westminster.

PAC WOMEN'S TRACK & FIELD ATHLETE OF THE WEEK

LIBBY HAUSER

Thiel College

Junior - javelin Greenville, Pa./Reynolds H.S.

Hauser won the javelin competition at the Marv Frye Invitational at Ohio Wesleyan University in Delaware, Ohio, posting a throw of 141-4 to provisionally qualify for the 2004 NCAA Division III Outdoor Track & Field Championships. Her throw is currently ranked fifth in the country and is just 13 inches short of the automatic qualification mark (142-5).

Also nominated was sophomore **Mallory Roadman** of Bethany and freshman **Rachael Cooper** of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

The Bison competed at Mount Union Saturday ... For the men, Chris Gardner won the long jump with a leap of 21-1, placed third in the high jump (6-0) and led off for the 4x100 meter relay squad, which placed third in 45.02 ... The other three members of the team were Mike Frazier, Aaron Weathers and Lavel Williams ... Frazier also ran the 200 for the first time in his career and finished in eighth place (23.91) ... Weathers placed sixth in the 400 meters (53.83) ... Also placing was Mark Brown, who finished eighth in the shot put (42-5) ... On the women's side, the only Bison competitor was Mallory Roadman, who improved her time in the 5,000 from last week by 13 seconds, finishing ninth in 20:14.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Washington & Jefferson men's track and field team competed at the Carnegie Mellon Invitational on Saturday afternoon at Gesling Stadium ... The Presidents competed on an individual basis only ... Junior **Chad Edwards** placed second in the shot put with a long toss of 47' 11 3/4" ... **Eric Shuty** of Allegheny won the title with a throw of 48' 11 3/4" ... Senior **Mark Rudolph** finished fifth in the javelin event after posting a throw of 128' 7", which set a personal best ... CMU won the men's championship with a score of 150 points.

Thiel freshman Lou Scudere claimed individual titles in both the 100 (11.02) and 200 (22.30), as well as a relay title in the 4x400 at Friday's Marv Frye Invitational, hosted by Ohio Wesleyan University Junior Libby Hauser won the javelin competition at the meet with a throw of 141-04 to lead the women's squad and provisionally qualify for the 2004 NCAA Division III Outdoor Track & Field Championships ... The 1600-meter relay team won with a time of 3:24.10 ... The squad was made up of Scudere, freshman Anthony Little, and juniors Derek Pugh and Daryl Moore ... Sophomore Adam Crawford took third in the javelin (166-03), while Moore finished third in the triple jump (42-1) and fourth in the 400 (50.96).

Westminster Titans

The Westminster College men's and women's track & field teams competed this weekend at the Mount Union College Invitational in Alliance, Ohio ... No team score was kept ... Leading the way for the Westminster men was sophomore **Adam Hadbavny**, who captured the discus (152-5) while also placing second in the shot put (47-3 1/2) and sixth in the javelin (160-3) ... The top Lady Titan finisher was freshman **Rachael Cooper**, who placed fourth in the triple jump (31-7 3/4).
