PAC MEN'S TRACK & FIELD ATHLETE OF THE WEEK

RORY PHILLIPS

Grove City College Junior - javelin Kane, Pa./Kane H.S.

Phillips provisionally qualified for the NCAA Division III Championships with a throw of 188-4 at Carnegie Mellon on Wednesday. he then captured the javelin title at Mount Union on Saturday with a toss of 183-2, giving him four javelin wins in four meets this year.

Also nominated was junior **Adam Llanos** of Bethany, freshman **Shaun Jackson** of Thiel, junior **Chad Edwards** of Washington & Jefferson, and junior **Matt Steve** of Westminster.

LIBBY HAUSER

Thiel College Sophomore - throwing events Greenville, Pa./Reynolds H.S.

Hauser won a javelin title for the fifth consecutive week after winning at Ohio Wesleyan University's Marv Frye Invitational. Her winning throw of 138-8 made her an automatic qualifier for the NCAA Division III Championships. She also finished third in the hammer throw (100-2).

Also nominated was freshman **Liz Mowl** of Bethany, sophomore **Christine Rummel** of Grove City, and freshman **Sonya Cole** of Westminster.

PAC TRACK & FIELD NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bison competed at the Mount Union Invitational Saturday ... The men's and women's teams were paced by the field events, as **Adam Llanos** placed 7th in the javelin with a throw of 157 feet, four inches ... Freshman **Liz Mowl** had the best finish for the women by earning 11th in the javelin with a best effort of 93-9 ... Senior **Samantha Martin** earned a pair of top 25 finishes in the shot put (13th; 32-9) and discus (11th; 100-10).

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Washington & Jefferson men's track and field team traveled to Alliance, Ohio, on Saturday to compete in the Mount Union Invitational ... No team scoring was kept in the meet ... W&J was led by sophomore Chad Edwards, who posted a ninth-place finish in the shot put with a toss of 44-10 ... Junior Sam Young finished 15th in the 200 yard dash (23.30) and 17th in the 100 yard dash (11.40) ... Sophomore Simon Setcavage was the Presidents' top finisher in the 400 yard dash, placing 22nd in a time of 56.02 ... The Presidents return to action on Tuesday afternoon as they compete in the Grove City Invitational.

Grove City Wolverines

The Grove City track and field teams both participated in a pair of meets last week ... The Wolverine men finished second to host CMU last Wednesday ... Rory Phillips provisionally qualified for the NCAA Championships in the javelin with a throw of 188-4 at CMU while Drew Martin won the long jump ... Nick Ondrasik claimed the triple jump while Matthew George won the pole vault ... At Mount Union Saturday, Phillips won his fourth javelin title of the year with a toss of 183-2 while Ondrasik grabbed second in the triple jump ... On the women's side, junior Sally Lewis took first in the long jump at CMU, then won the triple jump at Mount Union ... Christine Rummel finished first in the 400 hurdles at CMU.

Thiel Tomcats

Sophomore Libby Hauser just keeps on winning this spring ... At Ohio Wesleyan University's Mary Frye Invitational she captured the meet record, along with firstplace honors, in the javelin with a throw of 138-8 ... After provisionally qualifying for the NCAA Division III National Championships earlier this spring, her throw on Friday has automatically qualified her to once again represent Thiel this season, May 21-24 at St. Lawrence University in Canton, N.Y ... Hauser also finished third in the hammer throw with a toss of 100-2 ... Freshman Amanda Myers set a new school record in the women's 1,500-meter run, finishing 10th with a time of 5:08.84, shattering the existing school record of 5:09.18.

Westminster Titans

The Westminster College men's and women's track & field teams competed this weekend at the Mount Union College Invitational in Alliance, Ohio ... No team score was kept ... Leading the Westminster men was sophomore Phil Frye, who placed third in the discus with a toss of 149-5 ... Junior Matt Steve added a pair of fourth-place finishes in the 100 (:11.07) and 200 (:22.41) yard dash events ... Three different Lady Titans posted eighth-place finishes; junior Diana Barnes in the 400 yard dash (1:02.92); senior Briana Palko in the high jump (4-10) and freshman Sonya Cole in the shot put (35-4 1/2).
