The Waynesburg men were led by sophomore throwers Jeremy Faidley and freshman Sam Byrne ... Faidley took fourth in the shot put and Byrne did the same in the discus.

Westminster Titans

Westminster competed as individuals only at the event with limited members of each team attending the meet ... Senior Megan Harding won the 200 meters with a school-record time of 25.39 ...
