Sukits posted three solid performances at the unscored Mount Union Invitational in Alliance, Ohio this weekend to earn PAC Men's Track Athlete of the Week laurels. He captured the long jump (20-7.5), tied for first in the high jump (6-0) and placed second in the triple jump (44-9.5).

Both Bison teams competed at the Mount Union Invitational Saturday ... **Zac Cavalier** placed fifth in the javelin with a throw of 165-9 ... On the women's side, **Ashley Dougherty** claimed third place in the pole vault with an effort of 8-0.

### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J men's and women's track and field both placed seventh at the Pennsylvania Championships held at Geneva College on Saturday ... Freshman Shawn Wilson was the lone President winner on the day, finishing in a time of 14.92 to claim his third-straight 110-meter high hurdle title ... Junior Roger Snyder placed third in the 100 meters (11.04) and the long jump (19'0") ... Freshman Chad Edwards also finished third in the shot put with a toss of 43'5 1/4" ... On the women's side, sophomore Courtney Posey was the Presidents top finisher with a fifth-place showing in the 3,000 meters (11:43.99) ... Freshman Judi Rose also placed seventh in the discus with a toss of 101'08".

## **Grove City Wolverines**

At Mount Union, senior Scott Sukits won the long jump (20-7.5), tied for first in the high jump (6-0) and placed second in the triple jump (44-9.5) ... Junior Jeb Schreiber shared first in the high jump (6-0) and placed second in the 400-meter low hurdles (56.35) ... Sophomore Rory Phillips (174-0.) and junior Sloan McLaughlin (166-4) placed second and fourth, respectively, in the javelin ... Sophomore Sally Lewis placed second in both the long jump (16-7.5) and triple jump (35-1) ... Senior Phyllis Will placed third in the triple jump (34-0.5) and fourth in the long jump (16-0.75) ... Freshman Christine Rummel finished second in the 400meter low hurdles (1:11.30), while junior Jordyn Taylor took fourth in the 100-meter high hurdles (16.40).

## Thiel Tomcats

Both the Tomcat men's and women's track teams participated at the Ohio Weleyan Invitational last Friday ... The women finished in fifth place with 56 points, while the men came in ninth with 14 points ... Freshman Libby Hauser earned another first-place finish in the javelin with a throw of 126-10 for her fourth straight javelin title ... Senior Nakisha Logan had a terrific day all around, finishing in the top ten in all five of her events ... She finished eighth in the high jump (4-10), seventh in the long jump (15-9 3/4), fourth in the 100-meter high hurdles (16.59), seventh in the 100meter dash (13.59), and eighth in the 200-meter dash (27.74).

### Westminster Titans

Westminster competed at the Mount Union Invitational on Saturday ... The lone WC winners were junior Andy Pazul, who tied for first in the men's high jump (6-0), and freshman Katie McKissick, who captured the women's 400 meter hurdles (1:10.30) ... Other top performers on the men's side included senior Jacob Gleason (2nd in both 3000 steeplechase and 5000 meter run) and sophomore Matt Steve (3rd in 100 & 200 meter dashes) ... For the Lady Titans, senior Ashley Pyle tied for third in the 100 meter dash nad placed third in the 200 meter dash, while junior Briana Palko tied for fifth in the high jump.
