

Bethany Bison

The Bison track teams persevered through rainy conditions at Westminster Saturday to turn in solid efforts ... The men's team placed ninth out of 13 and did most of its damage in the sprints ... **Greg Williams** earned second in the 100 (11.84), just



beating out Raymear Pinchom, who was third (11.87) and Marcus Johnson, who earned sixth ... Arkangelo James ran to a third place finish in the 400 (51.54) and Pinchom snapped up sixth in the 200 (23.84), while the 4x100 relay team claimed second (44.98) ... In the field, Ben Gregg ran his streak of top-three placements to four consecutive meets by taking second in the javelin (154-0) and senior Ken Barrows took third in the high jump ... The women finished seventh out of 11 and their top showing was from Desiree Finley with a second in the 100 hurdles (17.47), while Kelli McAbier took sixth ... In the 100, Paige Prato crossed in fifth place (13.72) and Kaitlyn Black also earned fifth in the 400 with a season-best time of 1:02.64.

The 1600 relay quartet closed the meet by winning in 3:24.44 ... Mark Talbot won the 10K for Grove City ... Fisher won the 5K Saturday in New Wilmington, helping the Wolverines to seventh place in the team standings ... Senior Emily Pierce earned second in the 5000 ... The Wolverine thinclads are idle this week for Easter Break ... Grove City returns to action April 29-30 for the PAC Championships at Bethany.

Thiel Tomcats

Ethan Rowe topped a 21-runner field to win the 400-meter dash at the Westminster Invitational on Saturday ... He won the event with a time of 51.43 despite running from the second heat ... Regis Wagner and Brendan DuLaney both posted per-



sonal-best times in their events ... Wagner was third in the 1,500-meter run with a time of 4:09.50, while DuLaney took fourth in the 5,000-meter run with a time of 15:53.17 ... **Scott Stano** finished fifth in the javelin ... Three Thiel women placed in the top ten at Westminster ... **Cassidy Kravec** took third in the javelin with her throw of 100-3 ... **Joy Metzler** (shot put) and **Moriah Monroe** (400-meter hurdles) each took 10th ... **Valerie White** had a personal-best time of 19:44.17 in the 5,000-meter run and finished 11th.

The Jacket women were led on the track by senior **Maria Shepas**, who won the women's 3000 meter steeplechase (11:47.46) to qualify for the ECAC Championships ... Sophomore **Jaimee Post** will join Shepas at ECACs, as she qualified in the triple jump by taking first in the event, clearing 11.11 meters (36' 5.5") ... She added a fourth place finish in the long jump (14' 11.5") ... The WU men were led on the track by junior **Jordan Wrask**, as he bested a field of 28 runners to take first in the 100 meter dash (11.53) ... The Jacket men were led in the field events once again by sophomore thrower **Kurt Bonnet**, who hurled the discus 44.22 meters (145' 1") to finish first in a field of 22 throwers.

Geneva's distance runners continued to shine with Sarah Davis winning the top spot in the 10000 meter event on Saturday and Nick Edinger taking home the top prize in the men's 5000 meter race ... Other winners in Wednesday's meet included Shannon Rech (3000 meter steeplechase), Emily Crain (long jump) and Kathryn Regalado (shot put) for the women ...
