Rummel won the 400 hurdles (1:10.49), placed second in the triple jump (34-6 1/2), third in the long jump (16-0) and fourth in the 100 hurdles (17:11) at the five-team Grove City College meet on Saturday.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Washington & Jefferson men's track and field team placed sixth of six teams at the Grove City College Meet on Tuesday afternoon at Robert E. Thorn Field ... Sophomore **Chad Edwards** earned W&J's top finish in all events by placing third in the shot put, following a throw of 44-11 ... Junior **Scott Chodor** posted a fourth-place finish in the discus (124-6), while freshman **Adam Sarver** garnered a fifth-place showing in the high jump (5-10) ... W&J competes in the PAC Championships this weekend at Wesminster.

Grove City Wolverines

The GCC track and field teams hosted a six-school meet last Tuesday at Robert E. Thorn Field ... Christine Rummel (400 hurdles) and Sally Lewis (long jump) were both winners for the Lady Wolverines, who earned 98 team points ... Freshman Michelle Borza took second in the 400 hurdles and third in the high jump while Christine Bare and Megan Skarada tied for second in the 10,000 ... On the men's side, junior Rory Phillips took second in the javelin while Steve Brown earned runner-up in the 5000 ... Senior Josh Christy took second in the 400 hurdles while senior Nick Ondrasik placed third in the triple jump ... Both GCC teams are four-time defending PAC champions in track and field.

Thiel Tomcats

Sophomore Libby Hauser's consecutive win streak in the javelin may be over, but even with a second-place finish she continues her drive to become one of the college's top throwers ever ... Her throw of 143-7 Saturday was not only good enough for second place at the Slippery Rock University Invitational, but it was enough to best Amy Leslie's throw of 140-7 in 1992 for the top javelin throw ever by a Thiel female student-athlete ... Hauser also won the hammer throw with a mark of 127-8 ... Junior Richard Purdy won the men's high jump with a leap of 6-8, which provisionally qualifies him for the NCAA Division III Outdoor Track & Field Championships ... Freshman Shaun Jackson won the men's 400 (49.62).

Westminster Titans

Westminster competed Tuesday at the Grove City College meet ... The Titan men finished fifth out of six teams with 71 points, while the Lady Titans were fourth out of five teams with 74 points ... Leading the Westminster men was freshman Adam Hadbavny, who was second in the discus (136-11), third in the javelin (161-8) and fourth in the shot put (44-7) ... Two other Titans posted second place finishes: junior Sean Gallagher in the 10,000 (36:34) and freshman Jason Bedillion in the high jump (6-0) ... Three Lady Titans posted wins at the event, led by senior Katie Spehar, who captured the 800 (2:24.31) ... Junior Kacie Zbur won the high jump (4-8), while sophomore Erica Tallo captured the javelin (101-1).
