Jackson posted first-place finishes in three events at the Westminster Invitational, as he captured the 400 meter dash (50.41) while running legs for the Tomcats' winning 4x100 (44.14) and 4x400 (3:28.64) relay teams.

Also nominated was freshman **Jeremy Hurt** of Grove City, freshman **Virgil Marshall** of Washington & Jefferson, sophomore **Heath Piper** of Waynesburg, and senior **Marcus Corvino** of Westminster.

Gibson was a triple-winner for the Tomcats at the Westminster Invitational on Saturday, as she won both the 100 (12.58) and 200 (26.57) meter dashes while running a leg for the victorious 4x100 meter relay team (52.79).

Also nominated was **Lauren Spegal** of Bethany, senior **Christine Rummel** of Grove City, freshman **Kelli Gee** of Washington & Jefferson, freshman **Haley Hinds** of Waynesburg, and freshman **Jessica Cooper** of Westminster.

## PAC TRACK & FIELD NOTES

#### **Bethany Bison**

Bethany's track and field teams faired well in preparation of the PAC Championships Saturday at the Westminster Invitational ... For the men, Chris Gardner again proved his mettle, scoring victories in the 100-meter, the long jump and the high jump events for the Bison men ... Other notable finishes for the men include that of Ken Hopper, who suffered a hardfought loss in the 1,500-meter event ... Aaron Weathers finished third in the 400meters, setting a personal best for the year ... The women were paced by their distance runners in the 5,000-meter event as Bethany claimed first and third finishes by Mallory Roadman and Rebekah Cypert, respectively ... Roadman's time of 20:26.88 was a personal best this year.

#### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J will host the 2005 PAC Track & Field Championships this Saturday at Cameron Stadium ... This past week, freshman Virgil Marshall qualified for the ECAC Division III Championships in the long jump and the W&J women's 4 X 100 relay team also ran a ECAC-qualifying mark at the unscored IUP Invitational ... Marshall placed seventh in the long jump with a leap of 21'2 1/2" to advance to the ECAC event ... He was also second in the 200 meters ... In addition, freshman Tony Lewis placed fourth in the long jump after posting a mark of 22'1 1/2" ... Senior Chad Edwards rounded out the men's top performers with a third-place finish in the shot put (48'6") ... Kelli Gee placed second in the long jump event.

#### **Grove City Wolverines**

Both Grove City teams competed in the IUP Open Saturday ... Freshman Jeremy Hurt helped lead the men's team by winning the high jump ... Hurt also placed seventh in the triple jump for the Wolverines ... Senior Luke Henry earned runner-up honors in the 800 while freshman Bob Rummel took fifth in the high hurdles ... Freshman Matt Kulinski took sixth in pole vault while sophomores Mark Murchie and Jesse Sunquist took sixth in the 200 and 400, respectively ... Senior Erin Claxton helped pace the women's team with a third-place effort in the 5000 while Christine Rummel placed fifth in the 400 hurdles ... Sarah Bray took seventh in the javelin.

#### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg returned to Westminster for a second time this season as both teams competed in the Westminster Invitational ... A total of 15 different Yellow Jacket athletes finished events in the top five ... On the women's side, freshman Michelle Propst finished in first place in the 1500 meter run (5:01.91), while classmate Haley Hinds won the 3000-meter steeplechase (13:26.41) ... Also performing well for the Yellow Jackets was junior Kasev Hollabaugh, who finished in third place in the 100-meter hurdles and second place in the 400-meter hurdles ... Sophomore **Heath Piper** paced the men's team as he placed second in the 3000-meter steeplechase with a time of 11:15.00 and finished in second place in the 5000meter run with a time of 17:25.13.

#### Thiel Tomcats

Thiel competed at the Westminster Invitational Saturday ... Junior Kandiace Gibson and senior Kristen Benjamin each won a pair of individual events ... Gibson earned individual victories in the 100 meter dash (12.58) and the 200 meter dash (26.57), while Benjamin won both the shot put (40-6) and the discus (111-6) ... The women's 4x100 meter relay team won in 52.79 ... Junior Adam Crawford and freshman Anoia Rhodes each finished first in the javelin, as Crawford's winning throw measured 175-1 while Rhodes final mark was 98-9 ... Senior Daryl Moore won the 110 meter hurdles (16.47) and was second in the triple jump (40-4) ... Freshman Doug Lewis won the 200 meter dash (23.68).

#### Westminster Titans

Westminster hosted the Titan Invitational on Saturday ... Senior Marcus Corvino paced the Titan men by capturing both the 3,000 steeplechase (10:53.57) and the 5,000 meter run (17:27.0) ... Other men's winners included senior Josh Drab in the 800 (2:07.35) and junior Adam Hadbavny in the discus (46.46 meters) ... For the Lady Titans, leading the way was freshman Jessica Cooper, who captured both the high jump (1.57 meters) and the triple jump (10.46 meters) ... Other victorious Westminster women included sophomores Rachael Cooper in the 400 hurdles (1:18.31) and Sarah Calderone in the 800 (2:31.83) ... The Lady Titans 4x400 relay team was also victorious (4:43.70).
