tional automatically qualified him for the NCAA D-III Championships in the event. He is just the second Titan NCAA track & field qualifier since 2002-03.



# **PAC T&F NOTES**

#### **Bethany Bison**

The Bison warmed up for the PAC Championships by hosting the PAC South Quad Meet Wednesday ... The BC men totaled seven first places and were second out of four teams with 145 points ... **Arkangelo James** won the race of the day, beat-



ing two of the other top 800 runners in the PAC (1:59.31) ... The men's 4x100 team of Aarick Jones, Greg Williams, Adrian White and Kendon Noel took first and qualified for ECACs in 43.77 ... Other first places included Marcus Johnson in the 100 (11.19), Ben Gregg in the javelin (170-0) and Seth Myers in the shot put (41-10.75) ... Although Williams did not win the long jump, he did take second and qualified for ECACs in the event (22-3.75) ... For the women, Desiree Finley won the pole vault (9-8) and the 400 hurdles (1:07.11) ... Also collecting first place points was Kaitlyn Black with a season-best time of 1:02.33 in the 400 ... Finley and Black also ran on the 4x100 with Hayley Acree and Paige Prato to take second in the 4x100 (52.00).

#### **Grove City Wolverines**

The Grove City College track and field teams return to action this weekend in the Presidents' Athletic Conference Championships at Bethany College ... The Wolverines did not compete last week during Easter Break ... Grove City returns three 2010 conference champi-



ons in sophomore Sam Shesman (men's 800), senior Kate Balmer (women's 100 dash) and senior Emily Pierce (women's 1500) ... Pierce earned PAC women's track Most Valuable Performer after accumulating 26 points last year ... Grove City's women scored 84 points at last year's meet and athletes who accounted for 80½ of those points are back this year ... The men return 46 points from last year's total of 147 1/3.

#### Thiel Tomcats

Thiel competed at the Baldwin-Wallace Paul "Sparky" Adams Invitational on Saturday ... **Richard Peterson** had the top performance for the Tomcat men, taking sixth in a 39-runner field in the 5,000-meter run ... He crossed the line with a time of



15:28.76 ... **Scott Stano** finished 10th in the javelin with a throw of 152-02 ... Leading the Thiel women was **Cassidy Kravec**, who took eighth out of 42 in the javelin with a throw of 113-03 ... **Joy Metzler** also performed well for the throwers, taking 16th out of 42 in the shot put.

#### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jacket women took first out of three teams at the PAC South Quad with 124 points, edging rival W&J by ten points ... The men's team took first as well, scoring 164 total points, twenty points better than the second place team, Bethany



... The Jacket women were led on the track by senior **Mikey Macosko** as she qualified for the ECAC championships in the 100 meter hurdles for the second consecutive year ... The Jacket women won six total events, which included winning all three of the throwing field events ... **Angela Hagy** threw the shot put 11 meters to finish first in the field of 13 throwers ... The Jackets took first, second and third place in both the discus and javelin, with **Marybeth Rocco** winning in the discus and **Megan Sowers** taking first in the javelin ... The Waynesburg men won two events, and broke two school records ... **Kurt Bonnet** broke his own school record in the discus, while **Dougie Sanner** out jumped the competition in the triple jump.

#### Geneva Golden Tornadoes

Geneva once again traveled to New Wilmington Thursday for an unscored team mini-meet and provided several outstanding individual performances ... For the women, **Julia Urbanski** took first place honors in the 1500 meter event with a mark of 4:45.63, more than 15 seconds better than



the next closest competitor ... **Shannon Rech** won the 5000 with teammate **Sarah Davis** coming in with a close second ... **Aisha Moore** won the triple jump, while **Emily Crain** took second place in the long jump ... In men's action, **Ryan White** won the 200 with **Wes Marquis** finishing just .05 seconds behind in second place ... **Chez Anderson** and **Owen Struck** finished one-two in the 800, while **Nick Edinger** continued his dominance with another first place finish in the 5000 ... **Nathan Mansor** won the 3000 meter steeplechase with **Dan Dillman** taking first place in both the shot put and the discus ... Geneva's 4 x 100 also took first place.

#### Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Bearcats' participated in the PAC South Quad Meet, hosted by Bethany, on Wednesday afternoon, and established four new meet records ... In the 400, **Luke D'Amico** took first in 51.15 seconds, eclipsing the previous meet mark by .74 seconds ... **Chansler Poole** was victorious in the 1500, timed in 4:16.33,



also a new meet record, while **Jeff Hite** set a new standard in the 5000 (16.02.85) and **Cam Stumme** in the 3,000 steeplechase (10:13.00) ... The Bearcats 4x400 relay squad of **Kevin Wanichko**, **John Joseph**, **Shane Sweeney**, and D'Amico also took first, establishing a new meet record with a time of 3:26.73 ... As a team, the Bearcats were exceptionally strong in the 5K, with **Lucas Briola** taking second behind Hite (16:05.71) and **Ryan Barlow** third (16:06.56) ... Wanichko also added a second place in the 800, while **Justin Petrovich** took third in the 1500 and Sweeney fifth in the 400 hurdles.

#### Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J produced three double winners Wednesday ... Senior **Michelle Wuenstel** claimed first in the 100 (12.83) and 200 (26.32) meters ... Freshman **Lindsey Coffey** won the high jump (5'0 1/4") and triple jump (16'0 1/2") ... Coffey's long jump mark set meet and Bison Stadium records ... Junior **Taylor Hockman** won

the long jump (22'4 1/4") and triple jump (43'11 1/4") ... He too set meet and stadium records with both jumps, and took fourth in the 100 meters (11.30) ... Senior **Katelynd McElhany** won the 100-meter hurdles with a meet record time of 14.97 and claimed second in the 100 meters (12.87) ... Freshman **Cheyenne Mangold** finished second in the 200 meters (26.40) ... Freshman **Kia Ruhkamp** finished first in the 5,000 meters (20:40.05), while junior **Taylor Thompson** was victorious in the triple jump (33'10) ... On the men's side, junior **Bryant Wang** won the 110-meter hurdles (15.75) and classmate **Greg French** took the 400-meter hurdle title (meet record 56.14).

#### Westminster Titans

Westminster hosted the last of three consecutive home meets in nine days Thursday with the unscored Westminster Mini Meet ... The Titan women won six events and the Titan men won five ... Sophomore Adam Carswell won the



400 (50.77) before anchoring the winning 4x400 relay (3:28.28) ... Junior J.J. Faltot won the 100 (11.23), sophomore Mark Saylor won the pole vault (4.75), and junior Ryan Bell won the javelin (60.03) ... On the women's side, junior Mallory Mack won the 100 (12.71) and ran a leg of the first-place 4x100 relay team (50.13) ... The other track winner was freshman Haley Gabor capturing the 400 (1:02.08) ... Junior Merrissa Malcolm won the pole vault with her season-fank mark (3.4), while junior Alisha Slater captured the long jump (5.15) and junior Emily Dolsak won the discus (36.60) ... Bell was one of two Titans to compete at the B-W Sparky Adams Invitational Saturday, winning the javelin (64.87) with an automatic national qualifying distance.
