AC T&F NOTES

Bethany Bison

Bethany competed in its final tune-up meet before next weekend's PAC Championships by running at the unscored Baldwin-Wallace Sparky Adams Invitational Saturday ... The Bison's top place earned



Saturday was by senior Jodi Bodo, who finished second in a field of 26 runners in the 400 by crossing the finish line in 57.84, her fastest time of the season ... Bodo also ran in the 100 and finished 10^{th} out of 39 in the preliminaries with a time of 13.39 ... The other member of BC's women's team to run Saturday was senior **Desiree Finley**, who earned seventh out of 21 runners in the 400 hurdles in 1:07.03 ... In the men's running events, senior Taylor McNeil ran 11.42 in the 100 prelims and later posted a time of 22.89 in the 200 that was good for fifth place out of 49 runners ... For the Bison in the field, sophomore Seth Myers finished in 13th place out of 51 throwers with a best measurement of 129-11 inches in the discus, while senior James Malone competed in the javelin, taking 23rd overall with a throw of 134-9.

Grove City Wolverines

The Grove City College track and field teams will host the 2010 Presidents' Athletic Conference Championships at Robert E. Thorn Field Saturday ... The Grove City men's team will be in pursuit of its sixth consecutive



conference crown ... The GCC men's track and field team has displayed a quarter-century's worth of excellence as the Wolverines have won 17 league titles since 1986 ... The women's team has also been the conference's preeminent program, having captured seven of the last 11 conference titles ... The men's team will have four defending conference champions in the field in senior Derek Kruse (1500), senior Frankie Hourigan (3000 steeplechase), senior Matt Ridge (shot put) and senior Matt Six (disc).

Thiel Tomcats

A small group of Thiel track & field athletes competed at the Baldwin-Wallace Invitational on Saturday ... Freshman Brittany Brown highlighted the women's side of things as she tied for first in the high jump with a leap of 1.60m ... For the men, junior Ethan Rowe placed third in the 400 dash with a time of 49.7...

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

It was a highly productive week for Waynesburg track & field ... On April 21, both the WU men's and women's teams won team championships at the PAC South Quad Meet, hosted by Bethany ... It was the first team championship for the WU men



since the rebirth of the program in 2005 ... The Jacket women successfully defended their title from last year, thanks in large part to sophomore Krystal Baker, who won four events at the meet ... She placed first in the high jump (1.57 meters, 5' 1.75"), long jump (5.05 meters, 16' 7"), triple jump (11.66 meters, 38' 3.25") and pole vault (3.2 meters, 10' 6") ... She also set meet records in each of the four events, set a new school record in the triple and long jumps, and qualified for nationals in the triple jump ... Junior Maria Shepas also had a productive week for the Jacket women ... She recorded three individual wins over the two meets that Waynesburg competed in, and was part of the victorious 4x400-meter relay team at Bethany.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes

Geneva competed twice last week ... Wednesday at Bethany, Geneva's men finished second and the women placed fourth ... Highlights included Romaric Setodji's first place finish in the 400 with GOLDEN TORNADOES a new personal best time of 51.89 ... Nick Edinger



was first in the 1500 meter run, setting a new meet record (4:20.73) ... Eric Berkenpas posted personal bests in both the 800 and 1500 meter races ... Stephen Polite is Geneva's most recent NCCAA qualifier with his effort in the triple jump and second place finish ... In women's action, Julia Urbanski finished second in the 1500 meter and 800 meter races ... Kayla Jackson was second in the shot put and fifth in the discus while teammate Liz Michalak posted a personal best with a third place finish in the pole vault ... Saturday, Urbanski posted a pair of top ten finishes at the very competitive Baldwin-Wallace meet while Shannon Rech was seventh in the 5000 meter event ... Aisha Moore turned in a fifth place finish in the triple jump.

Saint Vincent Bearcats

Competing against a field consisting almost entirely of Division I and II foes at the St. Francis (PA) Invitational on Saturday, the Bearcats fared well, led by sophomore Kevin Wanichko, who captured first in the 800 with a personal-best time of 1:55.47 ... He was one of three SVC runners to finish in the top 10 in the race, as



Jared Long took sixth (2:02.55) and Mike Stevens ninth (2:08.85) ... The Bearcats also produced three of the top seven finishers in the 3K, paced by Jeff Hite's fourth-place time of 9:08.54 ... Cam Stumme took fifth in the 2K Steeplechase, with a time of 6:30.10, while Shane Sweeney led the way in sprints, taking second in the 400 (52.65) and seventh in the 100 (12.15) ... Matt Hagg led the Bearcats in the mile, taking seventh with a time of 4:23.80, while Stevens finished ninth in the race, crossing the line in 4:29.14.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J prepared for Saturday's 2010 PAC Championships last week at the PAC South Quad ... The Presidents had a number of strong performances, including sophomore Greg French who racked up victories in the 400 hurdles (56.22) and triple jump (43'10 3/4") and also earned second place in the long jump (20'11



3/4") ... The W&J women were paced by juniors Katelynd McElhany and Michelle Wuenstel ... McElhany set meet and stadium records during her wins in the 100 (15.39) and 400 (1:07.29) hurdles, while Wuenstel accomplished the same records during her 200 (25.89) and 400 (57.77) meter victories ... Freshman Scott Ryan set a meet record in the 800-meter run (2:00.85) and sophomore Bryant Wang placed first in the 110-meter hurdles in a meet record time of 15.49 ... Sophomore Taylor Hockman edged French in the long jump with a meet-record leap of 22'1" ... Senior Bryan Considder won the shot put title (46'1 1/4").

Westminster Titans

Westminster competed at the Sparky Adams Invitational, an unscored meet hosted Saturday by Baldwin-Wallace College ... Westminster collected 10 individual performances that placed in the Top 8, including five for the women



and two coming from senior Abbey Basta ... Basta placed fifth in the 200 (27.72) and sixth in the 100 hurdles (16.07) ... Sophomore Alisha Slater placed fourth in the preliminary of the 100 dash (13.18) but was a scratch from the finals ... The other two Titan women taking home Top 8 finishes were sophomore Merrissa Malcolm tying for fifth in the pole vault (3.15) and sophomore Emily Dolsak capturing eighth in the discus (37.70) ... Basta and Slater also helped Westminster place fourth in the 4x100 relay (50.10) ... The Westminster men also placed fourth in the 4x100 relay (44.09) ... Elsewhere on the men's side, three Westminster javelin throwers finished in the Top 8 led by senior Jonathan Morrow in fourth at 52.54.
