PAC TRACK & FIELD NOTES

Bethany Bison

Both Bison teams took fourth place at the PAC championship meet Saturday ... No Bethany athletes won PAC titles but several did take Second Team Third Team honors ... For the men, senior **Dwayne Wright** was Second Team All-PAC in the shot put (44-4) ... Senior **Zac Cavalier** (third in the javelin; 171-2) and freshman **Mark Brown** (third in discus; 115-3) and the Bison 4x400 relay team (3:46.98) brought home Third Team honors ... On the women's side, junior **Missy White** earned Second Team honors in the pole vault (8-6), while freshman **Carissa Moore** won Third Team recognition in the javelin (95-0).

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The W&J men won three individual championships led by freshman **Shawn Wilson**, who won the 110 meter high hurdles (15.44) and also placed second in the 400 meter hurdles (58.69) ... Sophomore **Scott Chodor** also won the discus (137'6"), while freshman **Chad Edwards** posted a first-place finish in the shot put (47'4") ... Junior **Todd Fry** placed second in the long jump (21'8") and third in the high jump (5'10") ... Junior **Roger Snyder** also finished second in the 100 meters (11.41) and third in the long jump (21'4") ... On the women's side, the Presidents were led by sophomores **Courtney Posey** and **Shawndra McDonald** ... Posey claimed second place in the 3,000 meters (11:31.07), while McDonald placed second in the high jump (4'8").

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City claimed its fourth straight sweep of the PAC men's and women's track & field titles, winning the men's crown by a 199-point margin and the women's championship by 52 points ... Grove City's men and women combined to place first in 21 of 36 events ... Junior **Jeb Schreiber** was named the PAC men's track & field athlete of the year after winning the 400-meter run (50.53) and 400 hurdles (56.82) ... Wolverine head coach **Bill Jordan** was voted PAC men's coach of the year ... Lady Wolverine junior **Jessica Cooper** set a new conference record in the pole vault with a first-place leap of 10-feet, six inches.

Thiel Tomcats

Both the men's and women's track and field teams earned second-place finish at Saturday's PAC Track and Field Championship ... The Tomcats finished the day with 12 conference champions and 14 individuals earning All-Conference honors ... On the women's side, senior **Sara Snyder** earned the 2002 PAC Women's Athlete of the Year award ... Snyder collected first-place finishes in the 400-meter run (61.88) and the 400-meter hurdles (70.77) ... **Bryan Williams** was awarded with the 2002 Women's Coach of the Year honor ... Senior **Kevin Wilder** led the men's squad with two first-place finishes, earning victories in both the 100-meter (11.27) and 200-meter (22.94) dash.

Westminster Titans

Westminster competed at the PAC Championships on Saturday ... Although the Titans and Lady Titans were ineligible for team and individual titles due to the school's reclassification from Division II, several WC athletes posted top marks in their events ... For the men, senior **Jacob Gleason** had the top time in the 5,000 and 10,000 meter runs, while sophomore **Matt Steve** posted the top times in the 100 & 200 meter dashes ... Lady Titan senior **Ashley Pyle** had the top times in the 100 & 200, while junior **Katie Spehar** had the top times in the 800 & 1,500 ... Five other Westminster athletes posted top marks in their respective events.
