PAC Volleyball Player of the Week

Morrow was named Tournament MVP at the Marietta River City Tournament after leading the Yellow Jackets to a 5-0 record and the invitational title. She averaged 3.23 kills per game at the tournament, including a 20-kill, eight-dig, five-block game against W&J and a 12-kill, 11-dig match against Marietta.

Also nominated was senior MH Shae Baxter of Bethany, senior OH Lisa Bodi of Grove City, junior OH Jerica Lamens of Washington & Jefferson, and sophomore OH Erin Hinks of Westminster.

PAC VOLLEYBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bison volleyball team won the Oberlin Tournament this past weekend with a perfect 4-0 record ... After dominating Oberlin, Olivet and Pitt-Greensburg to win its pool, Bethany recovered from a first game loss to win three straight and the tourney title from PAC rival Grove City ... It is just the second time in Bison volleyball history that they have defeated Grove City, with the first win coming in 1999 ... OH Shae Baxter (46 kills, 32 digs) and setter Brittany Vavrek (160 assists, seven aces) earned All-Tournament team honors... Senior Abbey Otto (42 kills, 13 blocks) and sophomore Peggy Emmerling (35 kills, 13 blocks) also had big weekends.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson, under first-year Head Coach Fred Wallace, opened the 2003 season with a 2-2 record at the 13th Annual Marietta River City Tournament ... Junior outside hitter Jerica Lamens was named to the all-tournament team after posting 62 kills, 12 digs and seven aces during the four games ... Lamens totaled 10 or more kills in all four contests, including a career-high 21 kills against Wooster ... Sophomore middle hitter Becky Fletcher notched 51 kills (3.2 kpg) and finished with a .467 hitting percentage ... Freshman Jamie Gullen dished out 139 assists (9.3 apg) in the first starts of her collegiate career.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City opened the 2003 season with three straight victories at the Oberlin Tournament ... Lisa Bodi paced Grove City during the first day of action with 23 kills and 30 digs in two matches while freshman Carlie Roberts racked up 13 blocks in the two matches ... Carly Denniston had 78 assists in the two wins ... Saturday, Grove City routed Lake Erie before falling in the title match ... Bodi chalked up 13 kills in the title match after serving seven aces in the win over Lake Erie ... Freshman Kelly Tinney had 17 kills in Saturday's two matches ... Grove City opens the home schedule Wednesday night against Hiram.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg is off to a quick start ... The Yellow Jackets went 5-0 over the weekend to capture the 13th Annual River City Tournament hosted by Marietta ... Waynesburg won four of its five matches in straight games, including a win in Saturday's final round over Carnegie Mellon ... Sophomore MH Brittany Morrow shined in her debut with Waynesburg since transferring from St. Francis (Pa.) last year ... Morrow was named Tournament MVP after averaging 3.23 kills per game ... Senior libero Kathryn Austen was named to the All-Tournament Team after averaging 2.05 digs per game ... The Jackets defeated PAC-rival W&J in the tourney's most closely contested match, as Morrow batted a season-high 20 kills (5 per game) in the match ... In the championship match, freshman MH Teia Suder posted 15 kills.

Against Allegheny, senior Diana Barnes tallied a team-best 12 kills, while sophomore Candice Anderson set up 20 assists.
