PAC VOLLEYBALL 2008 - Week 1 Conference Notes

24 AND COUNTING: The 2008 season marks the 24th consecutive season of volleyball competition in the Presidents' Athletic Conference ... Since its inception as a conference sport in 1985, Grove City has won a conference-high nine championships, followed by W&J (six) ... 2007 champion Westminster earned the PAC's first-ever automatic bid to the NCAA Division III Championships, while Saint Vincent won the ECAC D-II Championship for the second straight year and W&J competed in the D-III ECACs. AROUND THE LEAGUE: It was an impressive opening weekend for PAC volleyball, as conference teams posted an 18-9 (.667) record against non-conference competition ... Saint Vincent was a perfect 4-0 in capturing its own Bearcat Challenge tournament, while Thiel earned the team title at the Marietta River City Invitational with a 3-1 record ... Grove City senior MH **Natalie Liberati** was named Tournament MVP at the Marietta Invitational after posting 59 kills in four matches for the 2-2 Wolverines. **NEWS & NOTES:** Waynesburg went 3-1 at the Saint Vincent Bearcat Challenge, with the only loss coming at the hands of Division II Fairmont State ... **Amanda Jo Morgan** paced the Yellow Jackets with 53 kills ... Thomas More also went 3-1 over the weekend at its own invitational, opening with three three-set sweeps before falling to Spalding in the final match ... Freshman **Hillary Monnin** paced the Saints, recording 34 kills in just 65 attacks for a .477 attack percentage over the weekend.

Bethany Bison (0-0, 0-0 PAC)

The Bison begin their second season under head coach Courtney Kline this week with two trips to La Roche ... Bethany will take on the Redhawks

Wednesday night in a single match for their season opener ... BC returns to Pittsburgh Friday and Saturday for a tournament, where the Green and White will take on Chatham and Point Park Gold Friday and Roberts Wesleyan Saturday.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (2-2)



Geneva opened the new season by splitting four matches at the Johns Hopkins Tournament over the weekend ... After taking the first two matches GOLDEN TORNADOES on Friday against Goucher and DeSales, the

Golden Tornadoes fell to Widener and Johns Hopkins on Saturday ... Elizabeth Fisher was Geneva's lone representative on the All-Tournament team ... She threw down 18 kills in the five-game loss to Widener and led the Golden Tornadoes in kills in three of the four matches.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (4-0)

The Lady Bearcats opened up the 2008 campaign with a perfect 4-0 weekend at the annual Bearcat Challenge in Latrobe ... On Friday, SVC defeated Carlow and Pitt-Bradford by identical 3-1 scores, while SVC swept six

games with Dickinson and Pitt-Greensburg on Saturday ... Diana Petrovich led the way offensively on Friday, tallying 22 kills in the two matches, while freshman Taylor Guido combined for 28 digs in her first day of collegiate action ... Against Dickinson, Petrovich and Lauren Paddick both recorded eight kills, while Anna Wasik notched 11 blocks and four aces ... In the tournament's finale against Pitt-Greensburg, four different Lady Bearcats recorded at least five kills.

Thomas More Saints (3-1, 0-0 PAC)



Thomas More opened the season with a 3-1 record at the Thomas More Invitational ... The Saints tied for second place at the tournament ...

In four matches, freshman OH Hillary Monnin had a hitting percentage of .477 as she had 34 kills in 65 total attacks... She had two service aces while defensively she had 30 digs and six total blocks... At the conclusion of the Thomas More Invitational, Monnin was named to the All-Tournament Team.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (3-1, 0-0 PAC)



Waynesburg competed in the Bearcat Challenge at Saint Vincent College on 8/29 and 8/30, winning three of four contests ... Senior MH Amanda Jo Morgan

was second on the team in kills (53), first in attack percentage (.281). second in service aces (five) and led the team in solo blocks (13), block assists (25) and total blocks (38).

Chatham Cougars (0-1, 0-0 PAC)



Chatham University lost its season-opening match to Franciscan University 3-0, at home on Friday night ... In

the first game, Chatham junior Erika Juran served three consecutive points to even the score at 22-22, but Franciscan countered with three points to take the game by a score of 25-22 ... 
played on Sunday ... W&J returns just one senior in 2008, middle hitter Summer Baumgard.
