The Bison opened the year by finishing fourth at the Ohio Wesleyan Tournament ... Bethany opened the tourney by losing a tough five-game decision to Oberlin ... Junior Lauren Spegal recorded 17 kills, while senior Amanda

Bashioum totaled nine kills and eight solo blocks ... BC claimed their first win of the win with a 3-0 triumph over Wilmington the next morning ... Senior **Linzy Turner** had a team-high 11 kills, while Spegal finished with 10 kills, 13 digs and four blocks ... Sophomore **Kim McKay** had a big game with 33 assists, while senior **Angelina Allen** brought up 24 digs ... The Bison went on to lose their final two matches of the weekend to Bluffton and Grove City by 3-0 counts ... Overall, Spegal pounded down 47 kills, while McKay passed off 111 assists and Allen recorded 72 digs.



Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats opened the season by capturing the tournament title at the D'Youville College/Nickel City Women's Volleyball Tournament in Buffalo, N.Y. ... Thiel went 4-0 at the event, defeating Keuka 3-1 in the championship match ... Three Tomcats were named to the all-tour-

nament team: freshman MH **LaToya Locke**, freshman S **Kristen Martin** and sophomore LIB **Kari Zeleznick** ... Locke averaged 11.5 kills/match over the weekend to go along with 17 total digs and eight total blocks ... Martin averaged 35.8 assists/match while Zeleznick 11.5 digs/match.

W&J to a win over Olivet with 11 kills and 10 digs, while classmate **Taryn Terchanik** added 10 kills and five blocks . . . 2005 PAC Player of the Year **Jamie Gullen** notched 33 assists, seven kills, three blocks, and three aces . . . Zagari was also named to the Earlham College All-Tournament Team on Saturday evening.



Westminster Titans

Westminster posted a 2-2 record last weekend at the Mount Union Invitational ... The Titans dropped a pair of matches on Friday night before winning two matches on Saturday ... Westminster lost to Calvin in three games and host Mount Union in four ... The Titans beat Case Western Reserve in five games and Defiance in three during Saturday's action ... Junior OH **Diana Conzett** paced the Titans with 2.57 kills per game including a team high of six in the match against Calvin and 12 against Defiance ... Classmate **Rachael Coo-**

per had 12 kills and four aces against Mount Union ... Junior MH **Danielle Hogue** led the Titans with 15 kills in the win over CWRU, while three others, including Conzett, had 14.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City is 3-1 for the second consecutive season after a solid performance at Ohio Wesleyan's Bishop Invitational ... Junior **Heather Fraiz** and senior **Carlie Roberts** each recorded 12 kills in a season-opening win over

Transylvania ... The Wolverines then followed with a five-game loss to host OWU, as Grove City led 2-1 but could not secure the decisive third victory ... Roberts recorded 16 kills while LIB **Emily Rossol** had 21 digs and three aces ... Sophomore **Natalie Liberati** posted a dozen kills in a 3-0 sweep of Lake Erie, while Roberts' 10-kill, 7-block effort led a sweep of Bethany in the third place match ... Sophomore **Meghan Glenn** played in all 14 games over the weekend after playing in just 11 games as a freshman ... Grove City will face Saint Vincent Wednesday for the first time since 1992.



Thomas More Saints

Freshman MB **Leslie Hoelscher** began her college career with 86 kills in four matches, and averaged 5.38 kills

per game ... She compiled a hitting percentage of .527 as TMC opened the season 3-1 ... Hoelscher added 10 block assists, 10 block solos, 22 digs and four assists ... Junior Valeri Kuhn recorded 189 assists to move into second place of the school's all-time assists list with 3,027 ... She needs 432 assists to move past Peggy Westerstroem for the all-time lead ... Freshman Kristine Rust had a productive opener to career with 63 kills, which was the second best weekend total for the Saints ... Junior Jenny Schutte recorded a team-high 13 aces on the weekend.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets opened the 2006 season at the Saint Vincent Challenge, where they dropped four-straight contests, including three five-game matches ... Waynesburg fell to Pitt-Johnstown, 3-2, and

Point Park, 3-2, Friday before losing to Daemen, 3-2, and host Saint Vincent, 3-1, Saturday ... Against UP-J, OH Laurie Lindner posted a double-double with a team-high 29 kills and added 16 digs ... Freshman Caitie Morgan and junior Ashley Kreinbrook each registered a team-best 20 digs ... Lindner netted 16 kills and 18 digs against Point Park, while Kreinbrook led Waynesburg with 20 digs ... Freshman Jenna Heaston led WC with 28 digs against Daemen with Lindner posting a double-double with 11 kills and 22 digs. Against SVC, Mary Beth Crouch led the offense with 10 kills.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

Saint Vincent opened the season by winning three of four contests at the Bearcat Invitational ... Senior MH **Shannon McVay** averaged 4.07 kills per game with 61 kills over the weekend and was named to the All-Tournament team ... McVay added four service aces and 21 blocks

(10 solo, 11 assisted) ... Sophomore DS **Breanne Ezarik** posted 69 digs (4.6 dpg) and handled 101 passing attempts with only nine errors (91%) ... The Bearcats host Grove City Wednesday before competing in the Wooster Invitational over the weekend.
