Plyler earned All-Tournament honors after leading the Wolverines to a perfect 4-0 record and the team championship at the Ohio Wesleyan Bishop Invitational in Delaware, Ohio over the weekend. She averaged 3.53



For the weekend, she posted 53 total kills, a .344 attack percentage, six aces and five total blocks. Plyler recorded a career-best 23 kills in a Friday win over Oberlin.
