## PAC Volleyball Player of the Week

**SARAH MCKAIN**

5-10 senior middle hitter

McKain was named to the All-Tournament team at the Oberlin Invitational after leading the Lady Titans to the tournament championship with a 4-0 record. For the week-end, she posted 37 kills and a team-best 24 kills (10 solo, 14 assisted), while recording a .392 attack percentage (37-8-74).

Also nominated was junior OH **Peggy Emmerling** of Bethany, sophomore MH **Kelly Tinney** of Grove City, sophomore S **Jamie Gullen** of Washington & Jefferson, and junior MH **Brittany Morrow** of Waynesburg.

## PAC VOLLEYBALL NOTES

### *Bethany Bison*

The Bison opened the 2004 season at the Oberlin College Invitational on Friday and Saturday, Sept. 3-4, and finished in fourth place out of eight teams with a 2-2 mark ... The Bison fell to Grove City in the third-place match, 3-0 ... Bethany opened the tournament on Friday with a 3-1 (35-33, 30-25, 21-30, 34-32) victory over Kenyon College ... The Bison then fell to Westminster 3-0 (30-23, 30-26, 31-29) later that night ... On Saturday, Bethany started the day by defeating Lake Erie College, 3-1 (30-14, 30-9, 23-30, 30-20), before falling to Grove City in the third-place match ... **Peggy Emmerling** posted 49 kills and 14 total blocks for the weekend.

### *Wash. & Jeff. Presidents*

Washington & Jefferson opened its 2004 season with a 2-2 showing at the Marietta River City Invitational this past weekend in Marietta, Ohio ... The Presidents defeated Carlow and Wooster by 3-1 margins on Friday evening ... Senior OH **Jerica Lamens** totaled 31 kills and 17 digs in the two wins, while freshman OH **Beth Mihalik** racked up 13 kills in both games ... Sophomore S **Jamie Gullen** had 63 assists, 33 digs and 17 kills in Friday's action ... Freshman S **Emily Yaros** also amassed 47 assists in the victories ... Junior MH **Rebecca Fletcher** led W&J with eight kills and two blocks in the loss to Marietta ... Lamens led the Presidents with 15 kills and seven digs versus Urbana, while Gullen added 17 assists and six digs.

### *Grove City Wolverines*

Grove City took third at the Oberlin Tournament Saturday, going 3-1 at the two-day event ... Sophomore **Kelly Tinney** earned All-Tournament honors after averaging 4.3 kills and 1.2 blocks over 13 games ... She had 16-kill efforts against Olivet and Oberlin while sophomore **Emily Rossol** served 13 aces in the tournament, including five each against Olivet and Pitt-Greensburg ... **Kate DiMarco** added 13 kills against Oberlin while sophomore setter **Sarah Davison** doled out 147 assists over the four matches ... The Wolverines also went 3-1 at Oberlin last year, then proceeded to lose 14 of their next 15 matches.

### *Waynesburg Yellow Jackets*

The defending PAC champions struggled at the season-opening ASICS Invitational, held at Juniata College this weekend ... The Yellow Jackets suffered four defeats in the invitational, all of which were in three sets ... On the second day of the invitational, the Jackets faced Juniata and Wittenberg, both of whom are ranked in the top 10 by the AVCA ... Junior MH **Brittany Morrow** led the Jackets with 3.36 kills per game and 2.0 digs per game, while sophomore **Teia Suder** posted a team-high 0.67 blocks per game at the invitational.

### *Thiel Tomcats*

Thiel opens its 2004 season on Thursday with a non-conference match at Hilbert College at 7 p.m. ... The Tomcats will host a tri-match with La Roche College and Oberlin College on Saturday beginning at noon.

### *Westminster Titans*

The Lady Titans opened the 2004 season by capturing the Oberlin Invitational, posting pool wins over Lake Erie (3-0), Bethany (3-0) and Kenyon (3-1) before sweeping Olivet (3-0) in the championship match ... Senior **Sarah McKain** was named to the All-Tournament team after posting 37 kills and a team-high 24 blocks (10 solo, 14 assisted) in the four matches ... Leading the team in kills in all four matches was junior OH **Erin Hinks**, who finished the tournament with 54 kills and 47 digs ... Senior **Lauren Lalama** and sophomore **Rachael Cooper** split setting duties, posting 93 and 65 assists, respectively ... Cooper and freshman **Hannah Parker** posted 17 and 15 aces, respectively, with Parker adding a team-best 86 digs.
