## PAC Volleyball Player of the Week

KACI HLAD Waynesburg College 5-9 freshman middle hitter Byesville, Ohio/Meadowbrook H.S.

Hlad led the Yellow Jackets to a 2-2 week, including a win over NCAA Division II Fairmont State, by averaging 3.31 kills per game and posting a pair of four-block matches. She had 18 kills in the win against Farmont, while adding 15 kills apiece in matches against Rowan and Carnegie Mellon.

Also nominated was senior OH Abbey Otto of Bethany, senior OH Lisa Bodi of Grove City, junior MH Jess Erickson of Thiel, junior OH Jerica Lamens of Washington & Jefferson, and senior OH Diana Barnes of Westminster.

### Bethany Bison

The Bison suffered their first loss of the year with a 3-0 setback to visiting Malone ... Senior Abbey Otto led Bethany with 10 kills and seven blocks, including five solos ... Sophomore Peggy Emmerling added six kills and five blocks, while sophomore Brittany Vavrek totaled 28 assists.

## Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

After a 2-2 season-opening weekend at Marietta, the Presidents dropped four of five contests this past week, including a 1-3 showing at the Allegheny Tournament ... W&J was defeated by Marietta, 3-1, in Washington on Tuesday ... Junior outside hitter Jerica Lamens had 15 kills and 18 digs to lead the Presidents, while sophomore middle hitter Rebecca Fletcher added 10 kills and a season-high seven blocks ... Lamens notched 26 kills in a pair of losses on Friday evening at Allegheny before following up with 17 on Saturday ... Freshman setter Jamie Gullen collected 22 assists, six digs and four service aces in the 3-0 victory over Montclair State on Saturday.

## Grove City Wolverines

The Lady Wolverines went through a rough weekend in Berea, Ohio, dropping four matches over the weekend ... Senior Lisa Bodi accumulated 46 kills at Baldwin-Wallace while setter Carly Denniston had 117 assists at B-W ... The Lady Wolverines opened the week with a 3-0 loss to Hiram in Grove City's home opener last Wednesday ... Sophomore setter Robbie Long had 21 assists in her first collegiate start against the Terriers while Bodi and Renee Allen each had 11 digs ... The six-match skid is Grove City's longest since since a seven-match losing streak in 1992 ... That year, Grove City rebounded to finish 19-18 and win the PAC ... The Lady Wolverines open conference play Sept. 24 at home against Waynesburg.

#### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

After defeating Division-II Fairmont State on Thursday, 3-2, Waynesburg's seven-match winning streak to start the season was snapped Saturday, as the Jackets dropped two of three matches at the Frostburg State quad match ... Waynesburg improved its record to 7-0 with a 3-1 win over Rowan, before losing to the host Bobcats 3-0 and Carnegie Mellon, 3-1 ... Brittany Morrow averaged 3.31 kills per game during the week ... She batted nine kills against Rowan, followed by team-highs of 13 and 16 against Frostburg State and Carnegie Mellon, respectively ... Kaci Hlad, also leading Waynesburg with 3.31 kills per game during the week, registered four-block matches in the wins over Rowan and Fairmont ... Hlad had 18 kills against Fairmont.

#### Thiel Tomcats

The Thiel volleyball team opened the 2003 season at the St. Vincent College Challenge this past weekend ... The Tomcats finished in third place after defeating Penn State Altoona 3-0 in the consolation match ... Thiel started the tourney with a 0-3 loss to Urbana, but bounced back later that day to defeat Mount Aloysius 3-2 ... The Tomcats were handed another 0-3 loss by host St. Vincent before the consolation win against PS-A ... Junior MH Jess Erickson was named to the All-Tournament team, finishing with 25 kills (1.79 k/g) and five blocking assists (0.36 b/g) ... Senior OH Jan Willman led the Tomcats with 35 kills (2.50 k/g), eight service aces (0.57 sa/g) and 54 digs (3.89 d/g) ... Freshman S Erin Plaso finished with 87 assists (6.21 a/g) in the four-game tournament.

#### Westminster Titans

Westminster posted a 2-3 record and finished in fourth place at the eight-team Kilt Classic, hosted by the College of Wooster in Wooster, Ohio ... Senior OH Diana Barnes was the Ione Lady Titan named to the AII-Tournament team ... Sophomore OH Erin Hinks and freshman OH Rachael Cooper had 18 and 15 kills, respectively, in a five-set loss to St. Mary's (Ind.) on Friday ... Hinks again led the team in kills in a five-set Friday win against Heidelberg with 20, followed by Barnes with 16 kills and four blocks ... Hinks and Barnes had 13 and 10 kills, respectively, in a five-set win vs. La Roche, while freshman MH Katie McDermott added nine kills ... Barnes had an outstanding all-around game in a four-set loss to host Wooster, leading the team with 16 kills and 16 digs.
