Geneva captured the Johns Hopkins Invitational in Baltimore with three wins, including a 3-1 victory over the host school.

The Bison took first place at the Marietta Tournament to open the season over the weekend with a perfect 4-0 record ... It's the first time Bethany has

started the year 4-0 since 2003 and BC can go to 5-0 for the first time in school history with a win over Franciscan Wednesday at home ... Jessica Zavatchen averaged 36.25 assists during the four matches, with a high of 45 in the Kenyon triumph ... She earned All-Tournament team, as did Tiffany Hoffman, who totaled 41 digs over the weekend and served five aces in the LaGrange win ... Big hitters during the tournament included Jessica Cole, who posted 43 kills (including 19 vs. Kenvon), and Meredith Holl and Taylor Cassidy, with 31 kills each.
