PEGGY EMMERLING Bethany College

6-0 Freshman middle hitter Chester, W.Va./Oak Glen H.S.

Emmerling posted seven kills and 10 total blocks (three solo, seven assisted) as Bethany defeated La Roche 30-22, 30-28, 30-17 in the only match of the week for the Bison. She posted a .500 attack percentage (7-1-12) in the match.

Also nominated was senior MH Katie Summers of Grove City, sophomore MH Jessica Erickson of Thiel, senior S Andrea Motta of Washington & Jefferson, junior OH Ronnie Jo Meyers of Waynesburg, and senior MH Suzanne Fitz of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

The Bison won their only match last week, taking three straight games from LaRoche ... Junior **Shae Baxter** led the offense with nine kills and added six aces, while freshman **Peggy Emmerling** totaled seven kills and 10 total blocks (three solo, seven assisted) ... As a team, Bethany posted 31 kills and only 11 errors in 79 chances during the match (.253 hitting percentage) ... Junior **Jen Matovich** led the squad with 10 digs.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J went 2-3 in five contests last week, including a 2-2 weekend at the Allegheny Tournament this past weekend ... On Tuesday, the Presidents held a 2-1 lead after three games at Marietta, however, the Pioneers fought back to win the last two games to take the match, 3-2 ... Senior Andrea Motta paced W&J with 37 assists and 17 digs, while freshman Lakia Gordon notched a career-high 16 kills ... Motta averaged 23.5 assists and 13.5 digs in the four games at the Allegheny Tournament ... Freshman Becky Fletcher amassed a team-high 11 kills in the win over Thiel, while sophomore Jerica Lamens led the way against Penn State-Behrend with 10 kills.

Grove City Wolverines

The Lady Wolverines rebounded from a tough outing Friday with two wins at Baldwin-Wallace Invitational Saturday in Berea, Ohio ... Grove City won the "bronze" division at B-W ... Senior setter Cara Denniston collected 141 assists during the week's five matches while Katie Summers tallied four dozen kills, 48 digs and 12 total blocks ... Kirsten Pedersen posted 51 digs ... Grove City hosts Penn State Behrend in home opener Tuesday night at the Grove City College Arena.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

After winning its first and last matches of the weekend, the Waynesburg volleyball team finished second in its pool and fourth overall at the St. Vincent Bearcat Invitational ... Waynesburg bounced back from a loss to Ohio Dominican to sweep Point Park in the first day of competition Friday night ... On Saturday, the Jackets narrowly defeated Mt. Aloysius in five games and were later swept by host-team St. Vincent while attempting to advance to the championship match ... Katie Beall paced the Jackets with 77 assists in the two matches on Friday, while Kathy Twaddle recorded 13 kills in the win over Point Park ... Ronnie Jo Meyers starred in Waynesburg's win over Mt. Aloysius with 19 kills, and was named to the All-Tournament team.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel opened the week with their first win of the 2002 season, a 3-2 (27-30, 30-28, 30-18, 21-30, 15-13) decision over Penn State Behrend at Rissell Gymnasia ... Junior Jan Willman led the Cats with 18 kills, 8 digs and 2 service aces against the Lions ... Thiel competed at the 15th annual Allegheny College Volleyball Tournament last weekend, finishing in fifth place with a 0-4 record ... The Tomcats fell to Otterbein 3-0, Roberts Wesleyan 3-1, W&J 3-0, and Oberlin 3-1 ... Willman finished the four-match tourney with 49 kills (3.8 k/g) and 38 digs (2.9 d/g) ... Sophomore Jessica Erickson was solid in the middle for the Tomcats, collecting 53 kills (4.1 k/g), 13 solo blocks (1.0 bs/ g) and 6 block assists (0.5 ba/g).

Westminster Titans

Westminster posted a 4-2 week ... After sweeping Allegheny in their home openrer on Tuesday, Westminster went 3-2 and placed second at the eight-team Kilt Classic at the College of Wooster in Wooster, Ohio ... Both losses came in four games to eventual tourney champion Capital ... Senior middle hitters Suzanne Fitz and Katie Spehar were both named to the All-Tournament team at Wooster ... With 361 assists through 10 matches, senior S Carolee Reed now has 2,687 career assists and is just 231 assists away from surpassing Wendy Wissinger (2,917 career assists) for first place on the Westminster career assist charts.
