WHO'S HOT: Thomas More won the Mount St. Joseph Invitational with a perfect 4-0 record, as the Saints are now 7-2 on the season (7-0 against NCAA Division III competition) ... After starting the season with a 6-0 record, the Saint Vincent Bearcats have now won eight straight matches and 11 or their last 12 dating back to last season ... Geneva went 3-1 and captured the tournament title at the Hiram Invitational, including a 3-1 victory over the host Terriers (a 2007 NCAA playoff team).

ALL-TOURNAMENT: Grove City senior MH Natalie Liberati earned All-Tournament honors for the second straight weekend after posting 51 kills in four matches at Ohio Wesleyan for the 2-2 Wolverines ... Sophomore OH Courtney Holdrieth of W&J was named to the all-tournament team at the Presidents' Holiday INNvitational ... Westminster junior OH Beth Copp was named to the All-Tournament team at the Baldwin-Wallace Invitational after leading the Titans to a 3-1 weekend mark.


Chatham Cougars (0-3, 0-0 PAC)


