Washington & Jefferson College 6-0 sophomore middle hitter Manassas, Va./Osbourn Park H.S.

Linden was named MVP of the W&J Holiday INNvitational after leading the Presidents to the team title with a 4-0 mark. She totaled 53 kills and 16 digs for the weekend. Overall for the week, Linden averaged 12.0 kills per



match (3.16 kpg) for the 4-1 Presidents, posting a .322 attack percentage and adding four service aces.

Also nominated was senior OH Lauren Spegal of Bethany, junior MH Natalie Liberati of Grove City, freshman LIB Stephanie Shipley of Thiel, junior OH Laurie Lindner of Waynesburg, and senior MH Jess Cooper of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

The Bison began and ended the week with victories, with three losses at the Behrend Tournament sandwiched in between ... Lauren Spegal aver-

aged 4.3 kills game (69 total) during the week and reached three milestones ... In the D'Youville loss, she has 25 kills to set a new career-high and also move past **Shae Baxter** for third place in the all-time list at Bethany ... In Saturday's win over Medaille, Spegal, became the third player in BC history to surpass 1,000 career kills ... Other highlights to the weekend was **Kim McKay** matching her career-high with 49 assists and **Emily Stewart** delivering a career-best 15 kills, both of which happened against D'Youville.

Liberati earned Tournament MVP honors while senior Kate Skinner joined Liberati on the all-tournament team ... Liberati totaled 47 kills and a dozen blocks in the four sweeps ... The Wolverines are now 8-0 for the first time since 1985 ... It is Grove City's first eight-match win streak since 2001 ...
