Bethany Bison

Bethany split their four matches over the weekend at the Penn State-Behrend Tournament ... Junior **Lauren Spegal** hammered down 22 kills, her most since the final match of her freshman year, while senior **Linzy Turner** delivered 16 ...

Sophomore **Kim McKay** handed out a career-high 41 assists in the win ... Following 3-0 losses to Fredonia State and Behrend, the Bison concluded the weekend with a 3-0 victory over Medaille ... Turner paced the team's offensive efforts with 14 kills, while Spegal totaled nine in the triumph ... Spegal earned All-Tournament team honors after posting 49 kills, while Turner was a close second with 43 kills and McKay totaled 104 assists ... The Bison begin PAC play this week with a match against Westminster Wednesday night, which will also be their home opener.



Thiel Tomcats

Freshman OH **Abbey Kiger** and freshman MH **Liz Sitko** each finished with 15 kills to lead the Tomcats to a five-set win at Pitt-Greensburg Friday ... Freshman MH **Brittany Miller** added 10 kills ... Freshman S **Kristen Martin** totaled 47 assists while senior S Erin Plaso and freshman

OH **Monica Kurek** finished with 28 and 16 digs, respectively ... The Tomcats enter Tuesday's match with Ursuline sporting a 5-1 record ... The Tomcats were also 5-1 at this point in the season last year ... Martin is leading Thiel with 236 assists (11.24) per game while **Liz Sitko** has registered 18 blocks ... Also for Thiel, **LaToya Locke** has recorded 71 kills and 13 blocks, while **Erin Plaso** has averaged 4.22 digs per game.

Junior OH **Beth Mihalik** led the victory over Transylvania on Friday with eight kills

and seven blocks ... Senior OH **Stacie Ley** also added nine kills ... Junior OH **Gabby Zagari** racked up 20 kills in the five-set win over Dickinson ... Senior OH **Amanda Williamson** and Zagari both notched 13 kills ... Ley posted 16 kills and 18 digs in the loss to Marietta.



Westminster Titans

Westminster won all five matches during the week to extend its win streak to seven ... After beating Chatham at home on Tuesday, the Titans won all four matches at the Gettysburg Battlefield Classic over the weekend ... Westminster and Elizabethtown were the only two teams to go undefeated at the 18-school invitational ... The Titans defeated Gallaudet and New Jersey City in five games each and Eastern Mennonite and Catholic both in three games ... Senior MH Katie McDermott averaged 3.0 kills per game during the

week, including a .543 hitting percentage ... McDermott was named to the all-tournament team at the Battlefield Classic after posting double digit kills in all four matches, including a team-high 16 against Gallaudet.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City dropped a 3-0 decision at Saint Vincent Wednesday night in the Wolverines' lone match of the week ... Junior **Heather Fraiz** led Grove City with 10 kills while junior **Brittany Anderson** added nine kills ... Junior set-

ter **Kim Walsh** posted 33 assists while senior **Emily Rossol** recorded nine digs ... It was the first meeting between the teams in 14 years ... Grove City had won the previous four meetings with Saint Vincent ... Grove City opens PAC play Wednesday night against Waynesburg ... It is Grove City's home opener ... The Wolverines will also compete in the Westminster Tournament Friday and Saturday.



Thomas More Saints

Thomas More had a rough week, posting a 1-4 record ... Freshman **Leslie Hoelscher** had 66 kills (3.47 per

In the second match at Wooster, Mary Beth Crouch and Lindner registered 15 and 14 kills, respectively, against Saint Vincent ... Against Bluffton Saturday, Ashley Kreinbrook posted a double-double with 17 kills and 16 digs, while Lindner netted 10 kills and 15 digs ... In the tournament's final match, Lindner recorded another double-double with a team-high 12 kills and 11 digs, while Kreinbrook had 15 digs.
