5-7 freshman outside hitter Cincinnati, Ohio/McNicholas H.S.

Tyner avergaed 4.27 kills, 3.09 digs and 0.73 aces per game while leading Thomas More to a 3-0 week. including a pair of three-set non-conference wins over Transylvania and Wilmington as well as a fiveset thriller in the PAC opener against Grove City. She had a career-high 19 kills against GCC.

Bethany Bison

Bethany split four matches at Penn State Behrend's tournament ... After opening the weekend with a 3-0 win over D'Youville, highlighted by **Lauren Spegal**'s 12 kills, Bethany dropped a tough five-game decision to even-

tual champion, Fredonia State ... Spegal totaled 14 kills, while **Peggy Emmerling** had 12 kills and seven blocks ... In Saturday's matches, the Bison dropped Medaille in four games and had three players, including Spegal (20), Emmerling (16) and **Amanda Bashioum** (11) record double-digit kills ... The Bison could have gone 3-1 for the second straight weekend but Behrend took a 3-0 victory over BC ... Spegal earned All-Tournament team honors for the second consecutive tournament, as she totaled 59 kills.



Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats improved to 5-2 after going 2-1 last week ... After falling in their home opener to Point Park 3-0 Wednesday, the squad went 2-0 over the weekend with a 3-1 win over Hilbert and a 3-0 victory over Lake Erie Saturday ... The Tomcats won the first and second games, 30-

22 and 30-24, against Hilbert before dropping the third game 30-28 ... Thiel bounced back and posted a 30-25 win in the fourth game ... Sophomore OH had a career-high 17 kills to pace the Tomcats ... Junior S **Erin Plaso** finished with 22 assists while junior OH **Nicole Furman** had five kills and four solo blocks ... In the Lake Erie win, Klink had 11 kills and four digs while sophomore OHs **Steph Monus** and **Olivia Rogers** added nine and eight kills, respectively.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J opened 2005 with a second-place finish at the Penn State-Behrend Tournament last weekend .. The Presidents rolled past Medaille and host Behrend Friday and then moved into the championship final with a 3-0 win over Principia Saturday morning ... W&J raced to a 2-0 lead on SUNY-Fredonia in the final and had three tourna-

ment point chances, but ended up dropping a tough 3-2 decision ... Junior S **Jamie Gullen** earned All-Tournament honors with two 60+ assist matches, including 66 vs. Behrend ... Senior OH **Lakia Gordon** played a solid tournament, including a 23-kill, 11-dig line against the Lions ... Gordon and junior OH **Stacie Ley** both had 18 kills in the championship, while junior **Taryn Terchanik** added 16.



Westminster Titans

Westminster evenly split six non-conference matches last week ... The Lady Titan spikers hosted Allegheny for their home opener Wednesday and overcame a two-set deficit to post a come-from-behind 3-2 win over the Gators ... Over the weekend, Westminster recorded a 2-3 mark at the Wooster Invitational ... Sophomore **Hannah Parker** was the top gun for the Lady Titans vs. Allegheny as she recorded team-high totals of 16 kills and 27 digs while junior **Rachael Cooper** set up a season-high 53 assists ... Senior **Erin Hinks** had a

team-best 12 kills and 15 digs in the first Point Park match ... The tournament finale with Point Park saw junior **Katie McDermott** lead the offense with 14 kills.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City dropped a pair of hard-fought fivegame matches before closing the week with a 3-1 win over Wilmington ... Against Mount Union Tuesday, sophomore **Jennifer Plyler** posted a career-high 14 kills while sopho-

more **Katie Skinner** had 13 kills ... The Wolverines opened PAC action Saturday with a 3-2 loss at Thomas More but rebounded by defeating Wilmington ... **Carlie Roberts** posted 15 kills and a season-high nine blocks against TMC while junior **Emily Rossol** posted 22 digs ... Roberts added 14 kills and six blocks against Wilmington while Plyler and **Heather Fraiz** each had 11 kills and 13 digs ... Sophomore S **Kim Walsh** delivered 44 assists and 15 digs ...
