PAC Volleyball Player of the Week

Vavrek was named to the All-Tournament team at the Penn State-Behrend Invitational in Erie after registering 152 assists in four matches, including a season-high 44 assists against W&J. She also added eight kills and nine assisted blocks over the weekend.

Also nominated was freshman MH Kelly Tinney of Grove City, freshman S Erin Plaso of Thiel, junior OH Jerica Lamens of Washington & Jefferson, junior S Katie Beall of Waynesburg, and freshman S/OH Rachael Cooper of Westminster.

PAC VOLLEYBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bison rebounded from dropping three straight to winning out the consolation round at the Behrend Tournament... Despite 13 kills and six blocks from Abbey Otto, Bethany fell in three at Kenyon... On the first night of the Behrend tourney, Shae Baxter had 30 kills and Otto 27 in the two matches, while Brittany Vavrek had 37 and 44 assists, respectively, in losses to St. Vincent and W&J... Baxter and Otto again led the way in consolation round wins, as both posted 10 kills against Behrend and 14 kills against Medaille... Vavrek earned All-Tournament team honors after she recorded 152 assists in the four matches.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J finished the week with a 2-3 record after falling to Allegheny at home on Tuesday and posting a 2-2 mark at the Penn State-Behrend Tournament this past weekend... In the loss to the Gators, junior OH Jerica Lamens led the Presidents with 12 kills and 12 digs... Freshman setter Jamie Gullen recorded six kills in eight attempts, while adding 31 assists and two solo blocks... Lamens (14) and sophomore MH Ashley Savage (11) both racked up double-digit kill numbers vs. Penn State-Behrend on Friday and Lamens then recorded 24 more in a win over Bethany... Gullen also handed out a season-high 51 assists against the Bison... Lamens notched 31 kills and 46 digs in a pair of loss on Saturday... The Presidents open PAC play on Saturday morning by hosting Waynesburg at 10 a.m.

Grove City Wolverines

The Lady Wolverines snapped a 10-match losing skid Saturday with a 3-1 win over Notre Dame, Ohio... Freshman Carlie Roberts helped spark the win over Notre Dame with 13 kills and seven blocks while freshman Kelly Tinney had a team-high 17 kills... Tinney had 57 kills in the four weekend matches while Lisa Bodi added 42 kills... Sophomore setter Carly Denniston delivered 193 assists during the five matches last week... This weekend's action represented Grove City's final regular-season tournament action for the season... Grove City has non-conference matches with Allegheny and Wooster this week in preparation for the start of PAC play next week against Waynesburg... The match at Wooster is Grove City's first single match on the road this year.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

After losing three straight matches which blemished its 7-0 record, Waynesburg returned to winning form by capturing the Otterbein Cardinal Classic over the weekend, its second tournament win of the season... The Jackets won 4-of-5 matches, including a 3-0 win over Capital—the lone team to defeat Waynesburg during the tournament—in the championship match on Saturday... Waynesburg went down 2-0 to the host Cardinals in the semifinal round before winning three straight games, 30-17, 30-16 and 15-12... Waynesburg also won a decisive 3-0 (30-6, 30-12, 30-12) match over Lake Erie, and a five-game win over Urbana in pool play... Junior setter Katie Beall (12.53 assists per game) and senior outside hitter Ronnie Jo Meyers (3.11 kills per game) were named to the all-tournament team

Thiel Tomcats

After posting a 3-1 win in their home opener against Ursuline on Tuesday, the Tomcats dropped three straight at the Otterbein College Cardinal Classic before defeating Lake Erie 3-0 Saturday afternoon to claim seventh place in the classic... Senior Jan Willman was terrific against Ursuline, totaling 26 digs and 22 kills... Senior Erin Orahood finished with 26 digs, while freshman Erin Plaso handed out 34 assists to go along with her 20 digs... Junior Jessica Erickson led the Tomcats in their win over Lake Erie with 13 kills... Willman finished the match with eight kills and 10 digs, while Plaso added 27 assists and 14 digs.

Westminster Titans

Westminster dropped three of four matches at the John Carroll/Case Western Reserve Invitational in Cleveland... In the opener against CWRU, sophomore Erin Hinks led the way with 16 kills, while freshman Rachael Cooper added 14 and senior Diana Barnes had 10 kills, 16 digs and four solo blocks... Junior Lauren Lalama added 27 assists and seven service aces in the loss... Cooper led the way in a three-set win over Ohio Wesleyan, recording team-high totals of 14 kills and 16 digs... Hinks and Barnes pounded 18 and 12 kills, respectively, in a five-set loss to CMU, with sophomore Candice Anderson setting up 26 assists and senior McKenzie Crowell bumping up 13 digs... Barnes recorded a team-best 10 kills in a three-set loss against Marietta.
