PAC VOLLEYBALL 2009 - Week 3 Conference Notes

PAC PLAY UNDERWAY: The 2009 PAC conference schedule got under way last Wednesday with Geneva sweeping Grove City ... Over the weekend, Thomas More took the early lead in the PAC standings after sweeping a home tri-match against league foes Waynesburg and Chatham ... The Saints posted an impressive non-conference victory the same day, as Thomas More recorded a five-set win over #9-ranked Wittenberg at the Mount St. Joseph Invitational in Cincinnati.

NEWS & NOTES: Geneva senior **Adriane Blake** posted 16 kills against Grove City to become just the third GT player in history to record 1,000 career kills ... **Taylor Guido** of Saint Vincent, **Madison Chylik** of Thiel and **Courtney Sherwin** of host W&J were named to the W&J All-Tournament team ... **Jessica Zavatchen** of Bethany earned All-Tourney recognition at the Penn State-Behrend Invitational ... Westminster senior OH **Sam Botzum** was named to the All-Tournament team at the Wooster Kilt Classic.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: At 7-2 through the first two weeks of the season, Bethany has already eclipsed last year's season win total (five) ... Sophomore S **Michelle Clifford** set up 51 assists for Thomas More in the Saints' upset of Wittenberg ... Freshman S **Madison Sano** of Waynesburg recorded 38 assists in just four sets (9.5 aps) for the 2-1 Yellow Jackets last week, including 33 assists in a sweep of La Roche ... Junior **Inge Rasmussen** posted a team-best 13 kills for Grove City at Penn State-Behrend.

Bethany Bison (7-2, 0-0 PAC)



The Bison posted a 4-1 record last week and at 7-2 for the season, have already surpassed their victory total from last year ... In a 3-0 win over Pitt-Greensburg in the Bison home opener, **Jessica Zavatchen** had 27 assists and three aces ... Zavatchen earned All-Tournament team honors at Behrend after leading BC to a second place finish, their best showing at a tourney since taking second at Oberlin in 2005 ... She had 21 assists, 5 kills, 5 aces and 2 solo blocks against D'Youville and then passed off 36 assists and had 11 digs and 4 blocks against Roberts Wesleyan ... Also in the Roberts Wesleyan win, **Alyssa Schrecengost** recorded 13 kills and 12 digs, while **Courtney Meadows** added 12 kills.

Chatham Cougars (0-5, 0-0 PAC)



Chatham traveled to Crestview Hills, Kentucky to compete in a tri-match at Thomas More College against the host Saints and also Waynesburg University, both fellow PAC members ... The Cougars fell in three games to both Waynesburg and Thomas More.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (4-1)



Geneva opened its home schedule and its PAC schedule all on the same night last Wednesday ... In its only match of the week, Geneva cruised to a 3-0 victory over rival Grove City ... In the victory, junior **Adriane Blake** led the offense with 16 kills and became only the third Golden Tornadoes player to reach the 1000 kill mark for her career ... Blake got help from **Rachel Kuegler** with 10 kills while teammate **Laure Zerbe** added nine kills in the victory ... **Brandi Snavelly** continues to play flawlessly with 38 assists in the match ... The Golden Tornadoes will play three PAC matches this week beginning on the road against Thiel on Wednesday night.

Grove City Wolverines (3-6, 0-0 PAC)



Grove City went 2-3 last week, including a 2-2 effort at the Penn State-Behrend Invitational over the weekend ... Friday, the Wolverines topped D'Youville and dropped a four-set match with NAIA Roberts Wesleyan ... Grove City also went 1-1 Saturday as the Wolverines topped Lycoming and fell in four sets to host Behrend ... Sophomore **Anna McCurdy** collected 11 kills in the win over D'Youville and had 15 against Lycoming ... Junior **Inge Rasmussen** paced the Wolverines with 13 kills against Behrend ... Grove City opened the week with a three-set setback at Geneva Wednesday ... Sophomore S **Annie Barry** had 25 assists ... Grove City opens PAC play Wednesday night against visiting Bethany.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (5-4)



The Bearcats went 2-3 on the week ... Tuesday, SVC fell at second-ranked Juniata in three games ... **Natalie Hozak** led the way offensively, tallying eight kills, while **Taylor Guido** and **Christa Calgaro** finished with eight digs ... Saturday, in the first day of the W&J Tournament, the Bearcats split a pair of matches, defeating Thiel in four sets and falling in five to Penn State-Altoona ... **Diana Petrovich** had 10 kills in the Thiel contest, while **Rachel Pace** finished with five blocks in each match ... Sunday, the Bearcats fell in three sets to another nationally ranked foe – Salisbury – before rebounding with a five-set win over Susquehanna to wrap up the tourney ... Guido was selected to the all-tournament team.

In their final game of the weekend, Thiel overpowered Pitt-Greensburg, 3-0 ... Wednesday, Thiel prevailed over Hiram, 3-2, in front of an electric crowd at Beeghly Gymnasium ... Sophomore **Megan Kay** led the Tomcats racking up a team-high 14 kills while hitting .289 with 21 digs.
