Bethany Bison

Bethany went 3-3 last week, including a win over Chatham in their home opener and a semifinal appearance in the Behrend Tournament before settling for a fourth place finish.

Grove City Wolverines

For the second straight week, the Lady Wolverines went 2-2 at a tournament in the Cleveland area ... **Katie Summers** collected 56 kills over the weekend, including 22 against Kenyon ... Setter **Cara Denniston** collected 173 assists on the week, including 50 against Kenyon ... Against Behrend, **Kirsten Pedersen** tallied 13 kills and four aces while in second-day action at John Carroll, Pedersen had 42 digs ... Grove City begins defense of its Presidents' Athletic Conference championship Tuesday night in Greenville against Thiel at Rissell-Beeghly Gymnasium ... Since an 0-3 start, Grove City has won five of seven.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats dropped their only match last week, losing 3-1 at Hiram on Sept. 11 ... Junior **Jan Willman** led the squad in kills (12), while sophomore **Taneesha Williams** recorded four blocks (3 solo, 1 assist) and junior **Tiffany Snyder** dished out 22 assists ... After ten matches played, Willman leads the Tomcats with 110 kills (2.97 k/g), 16 service aces (0.43 sa/g) and is second with 148 digs (4.00 d/g) ... Thiel will open their 2002 PAC schedule against Grove City on Tuesday at 6:30 p.m. at Rissell-Beeghly Gym.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J posted its second-straight 2-3 week after falling to Allegheny, Carlow and Carnegie Mellon and defeating LaRoche and Waynesburg ... Senior S **Andrea Motta** posted 16 assists and 16 digs in the win at LaRoche on Thursday evening, while junior OH **Dana Wright** notched a team-high five kills and senior OH **Jessica Dott** added four kills ... Motta totaled 86 assists in the three matches at the CMU Quad Tournament on Saturday, including a 34-assist, 25-dig performance in the victory over Waynesburg ... Freshman OH **Kristen Baressi** also totaled 30 digs in the win over the Yellow Jackets ... Baressi also amassed a season-high 12 kills and 19 digs in the loss to Carlow ... The Presidents entertain Thiel in the home opener on Thursday at 6:30 pm.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg defeated Seton Hill 3-1 last Tuesday as **Kathy Twaddle** led the team with 19 kills ... The Yellow Jackets dropped two matches at the Carnegie Mellon quad match held Saturday ... Twaddle recorded double-digit kills in each of the matches including 14 in both the 3-0 win over Carlow and the 3-1 loss against Washington & Jefferson ... Waynesburg battled its way to earn the tenth win of the season, as the Jackets won two games of its 3-0 sweep of Carlow by the score of 31-29 ... The loss against W&J drops Waynesburg's record to 10-6, as PAC play starts Sept. 17 at Westminster.

Westminster Titans

Westminster posted a 4-1 week ... After posting a five-set win over Mount Union at home on Tuesday, Westminster went 3-1 at the John Carroll/Case Western Reserve Invitational in Cleveland over the weekend ... The Lady Titans' only loss came to Mount Union, which avenged its loss earlier in the week with a five set win of its own ... With 563 assists through 15 matches, senior S **Carolee Reed** now has 2,889 career assists and is just 29 assists away from surpassing **Wendy Wissinger** (2,917 career assists) for first place on the Westminster career assist charts ... Senior MH **Suzanne Fitz** has moved into third place on the school career kills charts with 1,201 kills, 125 away from topping **Heidi Jorgensen** (1,325 kills) on the career charts.
