After leading Geneva to the team title at the Hiram Invitational last weekend, Geneva sophomore OH Adriane Blake was named the NCCAA National Player of the Week on September 10 ... Thomas More was 3-1 last week, including a 2-1 mark to open the season against PAC competition ... Thiel opened PAC with a 2-1 mark, posting wins over Bethany and Chatham. ALL-TOURNAMENT: Grove City senior MH Natalie Liberati made it 3-for-3 this past weekend, as she was named to the All-Tournament team at the Westminster "Volley Against Violence" Inviutational ... Liberati, who was named to alltournament teams each of the previous two weekends, posted 91 kills for the week (4.14 kpg) ... Beth Copp made the VAV all-tournament team for host Westminster after posting 3.79 kpg ... Taylor Guido of Saint Vincent was tabbed to the all-tournament team at Gettysburg. **NEWS & NOTES: Courtney Meadows** of Bethany was tabbed to the all-tournament team at Case Western Reserve ... Freshman OH **Hillary Monnin** had 27 kills and 40 digs in four matches for Thomas More ... **Abbey Kiger** posted 43 kills and 23 digs in three PAC matches for Thiel last week ... **Camille Herby** had nine kills for Chatham in a loss to Carlow ... 
Thomas More Saints (10-3, 2-1 PAC)
