5-11 sophomore outside hitter Independence, Ky./Simon Kenton H.S.

Rust led the Saints to a perfect 4-0 week (2-0 PAC) by averaging 3.77 kills, 4.0 digs and 0.46 blocks per game. She posted totals of 49 kills, 52 digs and six blocks as the Saints dropped just one game on the week while moving into a first place tie in the PAC standings.

Bethany Bison

Bethany started PAC play with a tri-match at Waynesburg Saturday and came away with two losses ... In the opener against Grove City, senior

Lauren Spegal had 11 kills and 10 digs, while freshman Emily Stewart delivered nine kills ... Junior S Kim McKay gave out 25 assists, while the defensive efforts were led by senior Michelle Fowler with 21 digs ... The Bison would also lose 3-0 to Waynesburg in the second match, despite 12 and 11 kills from Spegal and Stewart, respectively ... Spegal also brought up 15 digs, while Fowler and freshman Sarah Olson each had a dozen.



Chatham Cougars

Chatham volleyball dropped three matches this week including PAC contests against Westminster College and Thomas More College ... Chatham has

been led by MH **Camille Herby**, who leads the team in kills and blocks ... Chatham will look for its first PAC win when the Cougars travel to Bethany on Tuesday, September 18.



Geneva Golden Tornadoes

Geneva dropped its first home match of the season to Point Park early in the week and then dropped its first two matches against PAC oppo-

nents over the weekend in W & J and Thomas More ... The Golden Tornadoes have the dubious distinction of having the worst start in school history at 0-11.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City opened PAC play Saturday by sweeping a tri-match with Waynesburg and Bethany ... Senior S **Kim Walsh** distributed a school-record 69 assists in a four-game victory over Waynesburg

... Classmate **Jen Plyler** recorded 21 kills while junior **Natalie Liberati** added 15 kills ... Liberati tallied 12 kills against Bethany, helping GCC to the sweep ... Senior **Kate Skinner** contributed nine kills while Walsh had 35 assists ... Grove City opened the week with a home setback against Saint Vincent, snapping GCC's season-opening eight-match win streak ... Liberati led Grove City with 13 kills while Plyler added 10 kills.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

Saint Vincent enjoyed a 4-0 week, beginning with a 3-0 sweep at Grove City Tuesday ... Junior **Jaime Kelly** had 20 kills and 14 digs, while freshman **Natalie Hozak** posted 14 kills and 11 digs and

senior **Kristin Hozak** had a team-leading 16 digs while posting 54 assists ... The Lady Bearcats then went 3-0 in a Saturday quadmatch at the Carey Center ... Kelly once again enjoyed a monster day, posting 14 kills against both La Roche and Thiel before finishing the day with a 23-kill, 24-dig performance in SVC's win over Gettysburg ... Junior **Anna Wasik** recorded 13 kills against LaRoche and picked up six blocks vs. Gettysburg.

Thomas More Saints

Thomas More dropped just one game in going 4-0 this week, including three wins over PAC opponents ... Sophomore OH **Kristine Rust** had 22 kills (3.77 kpg), 52 digs (4.0 dpg)

and six blocks (0.46 bpg) to lead the Saints ... Senior **Valeri Kuhn** had 152 assists (11.69 apg) ... Senior **Jenny Schutte** had nine aces in the win over Chatham as TMC recorded 18 as a team ...
