# ERIN HINKS Westminster College

5-9 senior outside hitter Warren, Ohio/Mineral Ridge H.S.

Hinks posted 63 kills (3.94 kpg), 37 digs, four assists, three blocks and two service aces while leading the Lady Titans to a 3-1 record and second-place finish at the eight-team Westminster Invitational. She posted a season-high 20 kills in a five-set loss to Wooster for the tournament title. For her efforts, she was tabbed to the All-Tournament team.

Also nominated was sophomore OH Lauren Spegal of Bethany, sophomore OH Heather Fraiz of Grove City, sernior MH Rebecca Fletcher of Washington & Jefferson, and freshman OH Laurie Linder of Waynesburg.

### Bethany Bison

The Bison dropped three matches last week to fall to 5-6 on the season ... Bethany split the opening two games with Marietta last Tuesday, but the Pioneers pulled out a 31-29 win in the third game and then won the match with a 30-

19 victory in game four ... Sophomore **Lauren Spegal** registered 12 kills to lead the Bison, while senior **Peggy Emmerling** notched 11 kills ... BC then lost twice at the Kenyon tri-match on Saturday ... Bethany won the opening game against Bluffton but the Beavers responded by sweeping the last three ... Spegal (16 kills) and Emmerling (12) led the offense again, while **Lindsey Cowser** gave out 40 assists ... The week ended with a 3-0 loss to Kenyon ... Emmerling led the team with eight kills.



#### Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats fell to 5-4 on the season after going winless (0-2) last week ... In the 3-0 loss at Ursuline, sophomore OH **Olivia Rogers** led the Tomcats with eight kills and a pair of service aces ... Junior S **Erin Plaso** finished with 27 assists while freshman MH **Steph Lardo** added

six kills and a pair of solo blocks ... In the 3-0 loss at Penn State-Behrend, sophomore OH **Steph Monus** finished with 12 kills while sophomore OH **Molly Klink** added six ... Plaso totaled 30 assists and freshman LIB **Keri Zeleznick** added 10 digs.



## Washington & Jefferson Presidents

The Presidents won their first three matches of the week to move to 6-1 overall, but dropped their two matches Saturday at the CWRU Tournament ... W&J opened its 2005 home schedule on Wednesday with a 3-1 victory over Carnegie Mellon as senior OH Lakia Gordon notched a match-high 16 kills and senior LIB Anne

Reynolds added 31 digs ... Junior S Jamie Gullen chipped in with 43 assists, five kills, five digs, four blocks and two service aces, while senior MH Rebecca Fletcher racked up nine kills, six blocks and three digs ... Fletcher also led W&J in the four matches at CWRU with 44 kills and 20 blocks ... Senior Megan Goodman had a team-high 11 kills in the win over Ursuline, while junior Amanda Williamson notched six kills and two service aces.



#### Westminster Titans

Westminster went 3-1 to finish in second place at the eight-team Titan Invitational in New Wilmington ... The Lady Titans went 3-0 in pool play, recording 3-1 wins over NAIA member Carlow and Ohio Wesleyan and a 3-0 blanking of Pitt-Bradford before falling to Wooster in five games in the title match ... Senior OH **Erin Hinks** and junior S **Rachael Cooper** were both voted to the six-player All-Tournament team ... Hinks recorded a team-high 19 kills in the Carlow win, while Cooper added team-high totals of 23 assists and five aces ...

Junior MH **Katie McDermott** led the team with 13 kills against OWU, while sophomore **Hannah Parker** added 23 digs ... Hinks led the offense with 14 kills against UP-B and 20 kills in the loss to Wooster for the tournament title.



## **Grove City Wolverines**

Grove City placed fifth at the Westminster Tournament Saturday by sweeping both Pitt-Greensburg and Pitt-Bradford ... **Heather Fraiz** led Grove City with 10 kills against UPG while **Carlie Roberts** had 12 kills and five

blocks against Pitt-Bradford ... **Natalie Liberati** added 10 kills against Bradford ... Friday night, Grove City dropped a 3-2 decision to Penn State-Behrend in pool play ... Fraiz recorded 17 kills and 19 digs while **Brittany Anderson** contributed 10 kills ... Liberati had eight kills in a 3-0 loss to Wooster ... Grove City opened the week with a 3-0 loss to Allegheny ... Five of Grove City's six wins have been 3-0, while four of the Wolverines' six losses have been 3-2 ... Grove City will compete in the Ohio Wesleyan Tournament.
