5-9 senior outside hitter Bethel Park, Pa./Bethel Park H.S.

Spegal led the Bison to a 2-0 week with wins over Franciscan (3-2) and PAC rival Chatham (3-0) by averaging 5.5 kills and 3.4 digs per game, including a .384 attack percentage. She posted a career-high 28 kills and added 22




digs in the Franciscan win, then posted 16 kills, five digs and three aces vs. Chatham. She now has 1,074 career kills, just 14 shy of second place on the BC career charts.

PAC win from Chatham ... Senior Lauren Spegal led Bethany to the comeback win over Franciscan by tallying a career-high 28 kills and also bringing up 22 digs ... Also setting a career-high was junior Kim McKay with 51 assists, while freshman Emily Stewart reached double figures with 13 kills ... Spegal (16 kills) and McKay (32 assists) guided BC to the PAC victory over Chatham ... Freshman Brittani Hall had six kills, while junior Mandy Kaufman and Stewart both had five.



Geneva Golden Tornadoes

At long last, Geneva's volleyball team finally picked up the first victory of the 2007 season on Friday night ... Splitting four matches this week-

end at the Carnegie Mellon Invitational, Geneva was able to avenge its loss to John Carroll to start the season with a five-set victory ... In the first victory of the year, freshman **Adriane Blake** threw down 21 kills and continues to lead the Golden Tornadoes with 3.57 kills per game.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Lady Bearcats enjoyed a 4-1 week, and were riding a season-high seven-match win streak before suffering a home defeat vs. Westminster Saturday ... In SVC's 3-0 victory over W&J Wednes-

Thomas More remained unbeaten in PAC action, dropping just one game in winning three matches – including a three-set victory over previously-unbeaten Grove City ... TMC

has dropped just two games during its eight-game winning streak ... Freshman Lindsey Svec had a team-high 18 kills in the GCC win, while senior Valeri Kuhn had 48 assists ... Freshman Libby Mulrey led the team with 34 total kills as the Saints averaged 15.7 kills per game ... Kuhn distributed 122 assists (12.20 apg) ... Freshman Tiffany Powell recorded a career-high 10 digs in win over Chatham.
