Bethany went 2-2 last week and is now 6-8 overall ... The team started the week at Pitt-Greensburg Tuesday and won, 3-0 ... **Angelina Allen** had 20 digs for Bethany, which is the most by a player this season for the team ... **Linzy Turner** had seven kills and 15 digs ... Bethany then played three matches at the La Roche Tournament Saturday ... BC defeated Point Park, 3-0 to start the day, then fell by scores of 3-0 to Mount Aloysius and La Roche ... Against Point Park, Turner had 12 kills and four digs, while **Lauren Spegal** recorded 10 kills ... Bethany will play just one match this week, at home against Washington and Jefferson on Friday, Oct. 1 ... It will be the team's PAC opener.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J improved to 6-5 overall after defeating Marietta and Hiram at Waynesburg Saturday ... Junior OH **Lakia Gordon** led the way with 42 kills and 10 digs in the two victories ... Gordon posted 22 kills, seven digs and two blocks in the victory over Marietta ... Junior MH **Rebecca Fletcher** added 12 kills, eight digs, four blocks and four aces in the win over the Pioneers, while sophomore S **Jamie Gullen** notched 40 assists, 11 digs and eight kills ... Junior libero **Anne Reynolds** also picked up 22 digs and two kills ... Gordon had 20 kills and three digs versus Hiram, while senior OH **Jerica Lamens** recorded 12 kills and nine digs ... Gullen had 33 assists and five digs. Senior OH **Mari Lynne Starr** totaled seven kills, three assists and two blocks.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City went 0-5 last week, including four setbacks at the Ohio Wesleyan Tournament Friday and Saturday ... Senior **Kate DiMarco** had 12 kills and 19 digs at Hiram while **Sarah Davison** had a season-high eight kills against Anderson ... Senior **Rachel Peterson** led Grove City against Ohio Wesleyan with a 12-kill, 26-dig effort Friday night while **Kelly Tinney** posted 14 kills Saturday against Bluffton ... Grove City lost all four matches Saturday by 3-0 scores ... Head coach **Susan Roberts** has 498 career wins and could reach the 500-win mark this week ... The Wolverines open conference play Thursday night against visiting Thiel.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

After posting a disappointing 1-6 record in the first two weeks, the Yellow Jackets rebounded with victories over Hiram and Marietta on Saturday at the PAC/OAC Cross Over held in Waynesburg ... The Jackets battled with the Terriers for a five-game victory after being down 2-1 for fifth-year head coach **Mike Bruno's** 100th career victory (all at Waynesburg) ... In that match three Waynesburg players posted double-digit kill counts, including **Teia Suder's** team-high 15 ... **Brittany Morrow** made 12 kills while also recording a career-high 28 digs ...
