PAC Volleyball Player of the Week

Lamens racked up 22 kills and 22 digs to lead Washington & Jefferson to a 3-1 victory over PAC rival Thiel in the only match for the Presidents last week. She has posted at least 10 digs in 15 of W&J's 18 contests this season, including four 20+ dig matches.

Also nominated was senior MH Abbey Otto of Bethany, junior OH Kate DiMarco of Grove City, sophomore MH Brittany Morrow of Waynesburg, and sophomore OH Erin Hinks of Westminster.

PAC VOLLEYBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bison had a six-match winning streak stopped with a loss to visiting Westminster Wednesday ... OH Peggy Emmerling had 14 kills, while MH Abbey Otto and OH Shae Baxter tallied 13 kills each... Setter Brittany Vavrek totaled 48 assists... BC then fell in three matches during a quad match on Saturday, losing to Dension (0-3), LaRoche (2-3) and Hiram (0-3)... The La Roche defeat was heartbreaking, as the Green and White rallied after dropping the first two sets and had three game points in the fifth set but LaRoche fought back to nip the Bison... Otto had 29 kills and 11 blocks on the day, while Vavrek was credited with 90 assists... Home has not been kind to BC this year, as the Bison are 10-3 away from Hummel Field House and 0-5 at home.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson picked up its first conference victory of the year on Thursday evening by defeating Thiel, 3-1 ... Sophomore middle hitter Rebecca Fletcher totaled 12 kills, seven digs and four blocks to lead the Presidents ... Junior outside hitter Jerica Lamens picked up a game-high 22 kills, while adding 22 digs and sophomore middle hitter Ashley Savage also notched eight kills, five digs and four service aces ... Freshman setter Jamie Gullen amassed 48 assists and 18 digs, while sophomore libero Anne Reynolds recorded a game-high 32 digs ... W&J looks to end its two-game season losing streak to Waynesburg on Tuesday evening and then hosts Westminster on Thursday ... The Presidents have defeated the Titans just three times in 29 all-time meetings.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City went the distance with Waynesburg in the conference opener last Wednesday night ... The Lady Wolverines trailed 2-0 but forced a fifth game and led 12-9 in the fifth before falling 15-13 ... Junior Kate DiMarco led Grove City with 16 kills against the Jackets while Carlie Roberts had 11 blocks ... Carly Denniston had 36 assists and 21 digs in the setback ... Grove City bounced back Saturday by splitting a pair of non-conference matches at Penn State Behrend ... Grove City dropped a 3-1 verdict against red-hot Frostburg State but came back for a five-game win over Behrend ... Kelly Tinney and Lisa Bodi sparked the victory with 11 and 10 kills, respectively ... GCC head coach Susan Roberts now has 488 career victories.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg improved to 2-0 in PAC play Wednesday night with a five-game win on the road at Grove City ... After starting the season 0-2 last year, including a loss on the road to the same Grove City team, Waynesburg is off to its best PAC start since 2001 ... The Jackets won the match 3-2 thanks to a 21-kill performance by sophomore middle hitter Brittany Morrow ... Senior Ronnie Jo Meyers also had a big night, as she batted 15 kills and recorded three blocks ... Katie Beall led Waynesburg with 56 assists, while Kathryn Austen paced the team with 15 digs ... The Jackets also improved to 14-4 overall with a non-league win at Mount Aloysius Saturday, 3-1, behind 19 kills from Kaci Hlad, 18 from Meyers, and 16 from both Morrow and Teia Suder.

Thiel Tomcats

The Thiel volleyball squad went 0-2 last week, losing both on the road ... The Tomcats fell at Wooster 0-3 on Wednesday before taking a 3-1 loss at W&J on Thursday in their PAC opener ... Junior MH Jessica Erickson had 10 kills and four service aces and senior S Tiffany Snyder finished with 26 assists in their straight set loss to Wooster ... After taking the opening game 30-26, Thiel dropped the next three against W&J and fell to 0-1 in the PAC... Erickson paced the Tomcats with 15 kills and senior OH Jan Willman posted 13 kills and 25 digs ... Freshman libero Erin Plaso notched a team-high 32 digs in defeat.

Westminster Titans

Westminster was 3-2 last week, posting a five-set PAC win at Bethany on Wednesday before splitting four matches at the Ohio Wesleyan Invitational ... Against the Bison, sophomore OH Erin Hinks tallied a match-high 20 kills with just two errors on 27 attacks ... Senior OH Diana Barnes tallied 10 kills while adding team-best totals of five service aces, three solo blocks and 18 digs ... Barnes and Hinks had 20 and 17 kills, respectively, in a four-set loss to Elmira on Friday ... Junior MH Sarah McKain had a team-high 10 kills while junior DS Sara Miller added 28 digs in a three-set loss to Bluffton ... Freshman MH Katie McDermott had five solo blocks in a four-set win over Otterbein ... McKain posted eight kills and five solo blocks in a three-set win over Hanover.
