Thiel earned two of its conference wins with sweeps of Waynesburg and Grove City on Saturday ... The Washington & Jefferson back-to-back contests last week to improve its Presidents' Athletic Conference record to 2-1 and its overall record above .500 ... Grove City is 3-1 in the conference, one game behind PAC pace-setter Thomas More.

**NEWS & NOTES:** Entering the week, the PAC enjoyed the top of the heap with four teams in the top 10 nationally for blocks per set ... Saturday, Grove City meets W&J and Westminster in a pivotal PAC tri-match; the Wolverines are 4-4 on Saturday this year ... Bethany matched their highest victory total with their win over Penn State-Fayette last Wednesday ... The Golden Tornadoes enjoyed a perfect 2-0 record against PAC foes last week but dropped a non-conference match against Frostburg State.

Bethany matched their highest victory total with their win over Penn State-Fayette last Wednesday ... **Jessica Zavatchen** passed out 32 assists and


