RONNIE JO MEYERS Waynesburg College

5-9 Junior Outside Hitter Windber, Pa./Windber Area H.S.

Meyers led the Lady Jackets to a 3-1 week, including PAC wins over Thiel (3-0) on Tuesday and Bethany (3-1) on Thursday. For the week, she tallied 57 kills in 15 games (3.8 kpg) while also adding a team-high 82 digs (5.3 dpg). She led the Jackets within three points of being 4-0 on the week, as Waynesburg fell in five sets to Division II Glenville State with a 15-12 loss in the fifth game.

Also nominated was senior MH **Katie Summers** of Grove City, senior S **Andrea Motta** of Washington & Jefferson, and senior MH **Katie Spehar** of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

Bethany snapped a nine-game losing streak with a victory over Oberlin Saturday at the Wooster Tri-Match ... The fourgame triumph was the Bison's first win since a win over Dickinson Sept. 14 at the PSU-Behrend Tournament ... The Bison opened the week with conference losses at Grove City and Waynesburg ... In the loss at Waynesburg, **Abbey Otto** tallied 15 kills and seven blocks, while **Peggy Emmerling** and **Shae Baxter** finished with eight kills each.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J posted a 2-2 showing at the Ohio Wesleyan Tournament this past weekend, advancing to the semifinals before falling to Anderson, 3-0 ... In the win over John Carroll, freshman OH Lakia Gordon sparked the Presidents with 19 kills and 23 digs ... Senior S Andrea Motta notched a season-high 52 assists and 27 digs, while freshman MH Becky Fletcher added 15 kills ... Junior OH Dana Wright also totaled 12 kills ... In Friday's action, Motta amassed 32 assists in the loss to Hanover, while sophomore OH Mari Lynne Starr had 11 kills ... Freshman MH Jerica Lamens led the way with 13 kills in the four-set win over OWU, while senior OH Jessica Dott and freshman OH Kristen Baressi each added 12 kills.

Grove City Wolverines

The two-time defending PAC champion Lady Wolverines improved to 3-0 in the PAC with a sweep of Bethany ... Grove City has not lost a game at home to Bethany since 1989 ... Head coach Susan Roberts is now 34-2 all-time against Bethany ... Heather Hayden and Katie Summers paced Grove City with nine kills apiece against the Bison ... Summers also had 11 digs ... The Lady Wolverines dropped three tight matches Saturday at Marietta, Ohio ... Against Division II Charleston, Summers had 14 kills, six blocks and four serving aces ... Cara **Denniston** paced the Lady Wolverines' effort against Marietta with 37 assists ... Kirsten Pedersen had 15 digs while Lisa Bodi tallied 10 kills against Kenyon.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg came three points shy of winning all its matches this week ... The Jackets defeated Bethany on Thursday, before splitting their two home matches against Glenville State and Ohio Valley on Saturday ... Waynesburg lost the deciding fifth game against Glenville State, 15-12, after a late rally ... Ronnie Jo Meyers led the Jackets this week with 57 kills in 15 games, including 19 against Bethany, while also leading the Jackets with 82 digs this week ... Kathy Twaddle registered 40 kills during the week, while Katie Beall led the team with 119 assists ... With injuries to freshman Lauren Freeman and Jennifer Hicks, the Jackets active roster is reduced to six players, as the team will enter the week without substitutes.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel dropped a pair of PAC matches last week, falling 3-0 to both Waynesburg and Westminster ... Against Bethany, junior **Tiffany Snyder** served up 30 assists while fellow classmate **Jan Willman** had 12 kills and five digs ... Willman had 10 kills and nine digs against Westminster ... Thiel will travel to New Wilmington this Saturday to participate in the Westminster College Invitational.

Westminster Titans

Westminster was 3-2 last week ... The Lady Titans swept PAC rival Thiel on Tuesday to move to 3-0 in league play ... WC then split four matches at the Ohio Wesleyan Invitational, defeating Otterbein and Bluffton while dropping fiveset matches to Anderson and John Carroll ... Senior MH Suzanne Fitz now has 1,299 career kills and is just 27 away from surpassing Heidi Jorgensen (1,325 career kills) at the top of the Lady Titan career kill charts ... Fitz had 21 kills in the Anderson loss ... Diana Barnes had 28 digs in the Otterbein win ... Katie Spehar tallied a team-high 14 kills against Bluffton ... Carolee Reed set up 43 assists in the loss to JCU ... WC is 23-0 against PAC teams since 2000.
