## PAC VOLLEYBALL 2008 - Week 5 Conference Notes

**TITANS STILL ON TOP:** Defending PAC champion Westminster remained on top of the league standings at 4-0 after a 3-1 win over Thomas More at Saint Vincent Saturday ... Host Saint Vincent managed to top both Westminster and Thomas More in five-set matches as part of a 3-1 week ... Geneva posted a 3-0 week to run its current win streak to 10 matches ... The Golden Tornados won at PAC rival Bethany before posting home wins over Penn State-Beaver and Houghton.

**WHO'S HOT:** **Adriane Blake** of Geneva recorded 18 kills with two errors on just 28 attacks against Houghton this weekend ... Grove City senior MH **Natalie Liberati** posted 34 kills and nine service aces for 2-1 Grove City last week ... Thiel sophomore LIB **Stephanie Shipley** posted 60 digs in three matches (6.67 dpg) for the 2-1 Tomcats last week ... Waynesburg senior S **Amanda Staudt** had 42 assists and 17 digs in a pair of matches for the 0-2 Yellow Jackets last week.

**NEWS & NOTES:** Saint Vincent will host the top ranked team in the nation, two-time (2004, 2006) NCAA Division III national champion Juniata on Thursday at the Carey Center ... W&J, which went 1-1 last week, was paced by sophomore MH **Courtney Sherwin** with 15 kills and six blocks ... Freshman OH **Courtney Meadows** of Bethany posted 31 kills for the 1-2 Bison last week, including 15 kills in a loss to Grove City ... Chatham remained winless following an 0-3 week against PAC competition.

### **Bethany Bison (3-12, 1-3 PAC)**

Bethany dropped its first two matches last week but snapped an 11-match losing streak by sweeping Chatham ... **Courtney Meadows** had eight kills and seven digs and **Tiffany Hoffman** brought up 19 digs in the loss to Geneva ... The Bison were able to claim the third set against Grove City, but the Wolverines won the fourth set to come away with the victory ... Meadows led BC with 15 kills, while two players had double figures in digs, including **Tiffany Hoffman** (22) and **Emily Stewart** (11) ... In the Chatham victory, **Megan Hoffman** passed out 16 assists, with eight going to Meadows and five going to **Carrie Talkington**, as the Bison knocked off the Cougars for the second time this year.



### **Chatham Cougars (0-10, 0-5 PAC)**

Chatham narrowly lost to Washington & Jefferson by a score of 3-0 ... **Camille Herby** and **Brittany Coscia** led Chatham with nine and eight kills, respectively ... The team lost in competitions against Grove City and Bethany in a tri-match at home on Saturday by scores of 3-0 ... Chatham plays their next game against Westminster at home on Thursday, October 2 at 7:00 pm, followed by a tri-match on Saturday, October 4 against Mt. Aloysius and Medaille.



### **Geneva Golden Tornadoes (12-3)**

Geneva's win streak has reached double digits with the Golden Tornadoes rolling to 10 consecutive victories ... Last week, Geneva defeated Bethany, PS-Beaver and Houghton all in three straight games ... In fact, the GTs have not allowed an opponent to take a game in five straight matches ... Vs. Houghton, **Adriane Blake** reeled off 12 straight service points in game one, including four service aces ... For the match, she posted 18 kills on just 28 attempts and two errors ... **Brandi Snavely** continues to lead the PAC in assists and posted 62 in the doubleheader sweep Friday ... Geneva's balanced attack saw four players register at least six kills in the PAC victory over Bethany Wednesday .



### **Grove City Wolverines (7-12, 2-3 PAC)**

Grove City improved to 2-3 in conference play Saturday by topping Chatham and Bethany in a PAC tri-match in Pittsburgh ... Senior **Natalie Liberati** paced GCC in the opener against Chatham with 11 kills and a career-high five aces ... Liberati also recorded 15 kills and four aces in the win over Bethany ... Freshman S **Annie Barry** collected 59 total assists in the two wins ... Sophomore LIB **Kim Budd** had 10 digs and three aces in the opener before posting 12 digs against Bethany ... Grove City opened the week with a setback at Thiel Tuesday ... Liberati collected eight kills while **Becky Chapa** and **Inge Rasmussen** each had seven kills ... The Wolverines will play four matches away from home this week.



### **Saint Vincent Bearcats (12-4)**

The Lady Bearcats went 3-1 during a busy week, losing to Carnegie Mellon before beating Mt. Aloysius, Thomas More, and Westminster ... **Diana Petrovich** and **Lauren Paddick** had nine kills apiece at CMU, with **Christa Calgano** posting 14 digs ... Paddick and Petrovich led the way again at Mt. Aloysius, with 13 and 10 kills, respectively ... Both of SVC's wins went five sets in Saturday's tri-match with Thomas More and Westminster ... Petrovich had 17 kills in the two matches, while **Anna Wasik** had 12 kills and nine blocks ... Calgano had 18 digs in the Westminster contest, while **Taylor Guido** notched seven kills and 10 digs.



### **Thiel Tomcats (8-9, 4-1 PAC)**

Thiel was 2-1 last week, including a conference win over Grove City ... Thiel needs just one win Saturday to match its overall and PAC win totals from a season ago.



### **Thomas More Saints (14-5, 3-2 PAC)**

The Saints went 1-2 last week ... Last week freshman outside blocker **Katie Sullivan** had a .349 attack percentage as she had 25 kills in 63 attempts ... Sophomore outside hitter **Libby Mulrey** led the team in kills with 45 (3.75 k/s) and recorded three service aces ... Freshman S **Michelle Clifford** had 142 assists last to pace the Saints' offense ... Through the Saints' first 19 matches this season, Sullivan leads the team with a .317 attack percentage, while Clifford has 690 assists ... The defense is anchored by freshman DS **Emily Bohman** with 264 digs and Sullivan with 34 total blocks.



### **Washington & Jefferson Presidents (6-5, 4-1 PAC)**

The Washington and Jefferson volleyball team split a pair of matches last week, including a 3-0 conference win over Chatham ... The Presidents currently sit in a two-way tie with Thiel for second place in the PAC, with Westminster leading the standings in first place with a perfect 4-0 conference record ... In the 3-0 victory over Chatham, W&J was able to get playing time for every active member on the roster as a total of 20 players saw action ... The Presidents will hit the road for a four-game road swing before returning to Henry Memorial Center on Oct. 8<sup>th</sup> for a 7:00 pm contest with Saint Vincent.



### **Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (5-10, 1-4 PAC)**

Against the Saints, senior MH **Amanda Jo Morgan** led the team with nine kills and also had three solo blocks ... Lindner added eight kills and Staudt chipped in 23 assists and seven digs.
