TITANS STILL ON TOP: Defending PAC champion Westminster remained on top of the league standings at 4-0 after a 3-1 win over Thomas More at Saint Vincent Saturday ... Host Saint Vincent managed to top both Westminster and Thomas More in five-set matches as part of a 3-1 week ... Geneva posted a 3-0 week to run its current win streak to 10 matches ... The Golden Tornadoes won at PAC rival Bethany before posting home wins over Penn State-Beaver and Houghton.

WHO'S HOT: Adriane Blake of Geneva recorded 18 kills with two errors on just 28 attacks against Houghton this weekend ... Grove City senior MH Natalie Liberati posted 34 kills and nine service aces for 2-1 Grove City last week ... Thiel sophomore LIB Stephanie Shipley posted 60 digs in three matches (6.67 dpg) for the 2-1 Tomcats last week ... Waynesburg senior S Amanda Staudt had 42 assists and 17 digs in a pair of matches for the 0-2 Yellow Jackets last week.

NEWS & NOTES: Saint Vincent will host the top ranked team in the nation, two-time (2004, 2006) NCAA Division III national champion Juniata on Thursday at the Carey Center ... W&J, which went 1-1 last week, was paced by sophomore MH Courtney Sherwin with 15 kills and six blocks ... Freshman OH Courtney Meadows of Bethany posted 31 kills for the 1-2 Bison last week, including 15 kills in a loss to Grove City ... Chatham remained winless following an 0-3 week against PAC competition.

Bethany Bison (3-12, 1-3 PAC)

Bethany dropped its first two matches last week but snapped an 11-match losing streak by sweeping Chatham ... Courtney Meadows had eight kills and

seven digs and Tiffany Hoffman brought up 19 digs in the loss to Geneva ... The Bison were able to claim the third set against Grove City, but the Wolverines won the fourth set to come away with the victory ... Meadows led BC with 15 kills, while two players had double figures in digs. including Tiffany Hoffman (22) and Emily Stewart (11) ... In the Chatham victory, Megan Hoffman passed out 16 assists, with eight going to Meadows and five going to Carrie Talkington, as the Bison knocked off the Cougars for the second time this year.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (12-3)

Geneva's win streak has reached double digits with the Golden Tornadoes rolling to 10 consecutive victories ... Last week, Geneva defeated Bethany, PS- GOLDEN TORNADOES Beaver and Houghton all in three straight games ...

In fact, the GTs have not allowed an opponent to take a game in five straight matches ... Vs. Houghton, Adriane Blake reeled off 12 straight service points in game one, including four service aces ... For the match, she posted 18 kills on just 28 attempts and two errors ... Brandi Snavely continues to lead the PAC in assists and posted 62 in the doubleheader sweep Friday ... Geneva's balanced attack saw four players register at least six kills in the PAC victory over Bethany Wednesday .

Saint Vincent Bearcats (12-4)

The Lady Bearcats went 3-1 during a busy week, losing to Carnegie Mellon before beating Mt. Aloysius, Thomas More, and Westminster ... Diana Petrovich and Lauren Paddick had nine kills apiece at CMU, with

Christa Calgaro posting 14 digs ... Paddick and Petrovich led the way again at Mt. Aloysius, with 13 and 10 kills, respectively ... Both of SVC's wins went five sets in Saturday's tri-match with Thomas More and Westminster ... Petrovich had 17 kills in the two matches, while Anna Wasik had 12 kills and nine blocks ... Calgaro had 18 digs in the Westminster contest, while Taylor Guido notched seven kills and 10 digs.

Thomas More Saints (14-5, 3-2 PAC)

The Saints went 1-2 last week ... Last week freshman outside blocker Katie Sullivan had a .349 attack percentage as she had 25 kills in 63 at-

Lindner added eight kills and Staudt chipped in 23 assists and seven digs.


Chatham Cougars (0-10, 0-5 PAC)


Thiel Tomcats (8-9, 4-1 PAC)
