

Kim McKay finished with 35 assists vs. Westminster, with freshman Emily Stewart (11 kills) and senior Lauren Spegal (10) leading the hitters ... On Saturday, BC took a game from both W&J and Thiel, but came up short in their pursuit of a second PAC victory ... Spegal had 15 kills and 17 digs against W&J, while freshman Sarah Olson totaled 20 digs ... McKay finished with 33 assists at Thiel and Spegal had another double-double with 12 kills and 19 digs ... Stewart paced the Bison with 13 kills against the Tomcats.



Geneva Golden Tornadoes

By far, the best week of the season for Geneva's volleyball team resulted in a pair of victories at Waynesburg University ... After dropping their

first 11 matches, the Golden Tornadoes have now won four of their last six, including three in a row ... Freshman **Adriane Blake** combined for 32 kills in Geneva's two victories over the weekend.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Lady Bearcats were winless in two matches last week ... On Tuesday, SVC made the trip to topranked Juniata to take on the 2006 national champions, falling in three games ... Jaime Kelly had

11 digs and eight kills, while **Christa Calgaro** and **Alyssa Dye** posted nine digs each and **Anna Wasik** and **Natalie Hozak** each tallying five kills ... SVC also dropped three straight games to Washington & Jefferson on Thursday ... **Lauren Paddick** led the way with nine kills, while Wasik picked up seven ... Hozak paced the Lady Bearcats with 17 digs.



Thomas More Saints

Thomas More is off to its best start circa 1999, and has won 11 straight matches ... The Saints remained unbeaten in the PAC with two wins, including a five-game thriller over

Westminster ... It marked the first time TMC has beaten the Titans at home ... Senior **Valeri Kuhn** led the Saints with 12.73 assists with 28 digs and 14 kills, including a 63-assist effort against Westminster ... Sophomore **Leslie Hoelscher** added 51 kills (4.64) with a hitting percentage of .390, while freshman **Lindsay Svec** added 41 kills (3.73) ... Seniors **Jenny Schutte** and **Michelle Headley** averaged 4.64 and 4.00 digs, respectively.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

After opening the week with a 3-1 victory over Thiel, the Yellow Jackets lost three straight matches each by a 3-0 count ... Against the Tom-

cats, senior **Ashley Kreinbrook** and junior **Laurie Lindner** each registered kill/dig double-doubles ...
