5-10 junior middle hitter Austintown, Ohio/Austintown Fitch H.S.

Bethany split a pair of matches last week, sweeping Chatham in a non-conference affair Thursday before dropping a 3-0 decision to Westminster ... Sophomore Lauren Spegal led the Green and White in the Chatham win by

tallying 11 kills and six service aces ... Junior LIB Angelina Allen totaled seven aces in the victory, while Peggy Emmerling had seven kills and three solo blocks ... In Saturday's match against Westminster, Bethany was serving for the first game at 29-26 but the Titans battled back for a 32-30 win and then took the next two games ... Emmerling posted a team-high seven kills, while senior S Brittany Vavrak, in her first start since returning from injury, gave out 23 assists.



Thiel Tomcats

Thiel dropped a pair of conference matches last week before going 2-0 at Saturday's Medaille Invitational in Buffalo, N.Y ... At Medaille the Tomcats downed Pitt-Greensburg 3-0 before posting a 3-1 win over the host Mavericks ... In the 3-0 (30-14, 30-28, 30-20) win over UP-G, sopho-

more OH Molly Klink tallied 13 kills while junior S Erin Plaso finished with 21 assists and freshman S Stephanie Lardo added 10 assists ... Freshman LIB Keri Zeleznick and sophomore OH Stephanie Monus added 27 and 17 digs, respectively ... Against host Medaille, the Tomcats battled back from a 23-30 game one loss to post a 30-25, 30-20, 30-21 victory ... Klink and sophomore OH Olivia Rogers totaled 13 and 11 kills, respectively.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

The Presidents swept a 3-0 decision at Thiel in their only match of the week ... Senior OH Lakia Gordon totaled 11 kills, four digs and two service aces, while junior MH Taryn Terchanik added 10 kills and three blocks for the Presidents ... Senior OH Megan Goodman chipped in with nine kills, five digs, two aces and one assist, while

junior S Jamie Gullen totaled 36 assists, 13 digs and three aces ... Senior LIB Anne Reynolds also finished with 13 digs ... Heading into last week's action, Gullen was ranked 10th in the nation in assists per game, while Reynolds was also 10th in digs per game.



Westminster Titans

Westminster volleyball opened PAC action last week with three-game sweeps of Thiel and Bethany ... Westminster head coach Tammy Swearingen earned her 300th career coaching victory against Thiel and is now 301-151 (.666) in her 13th season at the helm of the Lady Titan program ... Despite having the team's leading hitter (senior OH Erin Hinks) sidelined for most of the match due to illness. Westminster was able to defeat Thiel behind a match-high 13 kills by sophomore MH Jessica Cooper (New Castle/Laurel H.S.)

... At Bethany, junior S Rachael Cooper led the way with team-high totals of 11 kills, 19 assists and three service aces, followed by sophomore OH Diana Conzett, senior OH Erin Hinks and junior MH Katie McDermott with nine kills each.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City split a pair of road matches last week ... Freshman Natalie Liberati had 11 kills in a setback at Waynesburg Tuesday while junior LIB Emily Rossol added 24 digs ... Grove City bounced back Thursday, however,

with a four-game win at Penn State Behrend ... Junior Carlie Roberts had a season-high 23 kills on just 35 total attacks while Liberati and sophomore MH Brittany Anderson both had 11 kills ... Anderson also had five blocks ... Sophomore S Kim Walsh had 54 assists, giving her 114 in her last two matches against Behrend ... Grove City returns to PAC play with a home match against Bethany Wednesday ... It is Grove City's first home match in 22 days ... Each of Grove City's next four matches are against PAC opposition.



Thomas More Saints

The Saints had a rough week, going 2-3 ... After falling to Hanover in five sets earlier in the week, the Saints

went 2-2 in the Mount St. Joseph Invitational ... Senior Jody Clyde recorded the 1,000th dig of her career during the fourth game of the Heidelberg match ... After the weekend, she now has 1,021 career digs ... Senior Laura Wiegele has recorded at least 10 digs in 86 consecutive matches after recorded over 20 in all five matches this week ... She recorded over 30 three times and over 40 twice.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg opened PAC play Tuesday with a three-game sweep of Grove City before losing four matches this weekend at the Mount St. Joseph Invitational in Cincinnati ... Against the Wolverines, Laurie Linder and Kimberly Wilson led the offense with 11 kills each, while Brittany Morrow added eight kills and a team-high 15 digs ...

Waynesburg opened the MSJ Invitational with a 3-1 loss to Baldwin-Wallace, as Lauren Freeman recorded a team-high 15 kills ... The Yellow Jackets were swept by host Mount St. Joseph, as Freeman posted a team-best 20 digs ... Waynesburg started Saturday with a four-game loss to Centre before falling to Thomas More, also in four games ... At the tournament, Linder led the team with an average of 3.47 kills per game, while Freeman had 5.07 digs per game.
