PAC Volleyball Player of the Week

CARLIE ROBERTS Grove City College 6-0 sophomore middle hitter Union City, Pa./Union City H.S.

Roberts led the Lady Wolverines to a 2-0 week, as she posted 23 kills and 12 blocks while hitting. .432 for the week in wins over Penn State-Behrend (3-1) and PAC rival Thiel (3-0), the latter giving GCC head coach **Susan Roberts** her 500th career win. Carlie Roberts recorded 14 kills and six blocks vs. Behrend, then added nine kills and six blocks against the Tomcats.

Also nominated was senior OH **Jerica Lamens** of Washington & Jefferson, junior OH **Kimberly Wilson** of Waynesburg, and junior OH **Erin Hinks** of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

Bethany participated in just one match last week and was swept by Washington and Jefferson, 3-0 (30-19, 30-28, 30-24) ... **Angelina Allen** recorded a team season-high 31 digs, along with four kills ... **Peggy Emmerling** led the team with 10 kills and four total blocks (one solo, three assists) ... Freshman **Michelle Fowler** added a career-high 20 digs, while sophomore **Linzy Turner** contributed 14 digs and six kills.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J opened PAC play last week with home losses to Waynesburg and Westminster and a road victory at Bethany ... In the loss to the Yellow Jackets, junior OH Lakia Gordon tallied a team-high 15 kills and added six digs ... Senior OH Jerica Lamens posted 14 kills, seven digs and three blocks, while sophomore S Jamie Gullen finished with 25 assists, 11 digs and five kills ... Freshman OH Beth Mihalik recorded nine kills and eight blocks to lead W&J past Bethany Friday ... Lamens added nine kills, 11 digs and two blocks for the Presidents, while Gullen posted 37 assists, 14 digs and seven blocks ... Lamens recorded a team-high 18 kills to go with 15 digs, three blocks and one ace in the loss to the Lady Titans.

PAC VOLLEYBALL NOTES

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City picked up two home wins last week, giving head coach Susan Roberts her 500th career victory as a head volleyball coach ... Roberts is the 14th active Division III coach to earn 500 career wins ... Freshman S Kim Walsh had 60 assists against Penn State Behrend, a new Grove City record for a four-game match ... It is the fifth-highest single-match total in Grove City history ... Senior Rachel Peterson led Grove City with 19 kills and 22 digs ... Carlie Roberts added 14 kills and six blocks ... Roberts added nine kills and six blocks against Thiel while Kelly Tinney had a team-high 11 kills ... Kate DiMarco served three aces and had a team-high 14 digs ... Grove City is 3-0 at GCC Arena this season.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg proved it was ready for conference play by posting consecutive wins against W&J and Westminster ... In both conference games Brittany Morrow, Teia Suder, and Kimberly Wilson posted double-digit kills, while Lauren Freeman recorded double-digit dig counts, including 18 against Westminster ... The Yellow Jackets came away with a 2-2 split at the Mount Fall Classic held at Mt. St. Joseph this weekend with wins over Thomas More and Franklin ... Wilson garnered all-tournament honors as she posted a season-high 24 kills in the win over Thomas More and tied her season-high with 18 digs against Defiance ... For the week Wilson averaged 3.54 kills per game, while posting a 2.92 dig per game average.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel went 0-3 last week ... The Tomcats went down at home to Seton Hill 0-3 on Monday and dropped their PAC opener at Grove City on Thursday 0-3 before falling at home on Friday to Ursuline 1-3 ... Junior OH Erin Hinks led the team in kills in all three matches, finishing with 42 kills for the week, including 20 in the W&J win ... Sophomore Rachael Cooper and senior Lauren Lalama set up 55 and 47 assists, respectively ... Senior libero Sara Miller had 53 digs in the three matches ... Senior MH Sarah McKain tallied eight kills and four total blocks against the Presidents.
